## **Professional Recognition**

Graduation from the program would be considered by the Teacher Registration Board of Western Australia (TRBWA) to meet the qualification requirements for Provisional Registration as a teacher in Western Australia.

## Registration

You will need to graduate to be eligible to register with the TRBWA. Registration with the TRBWA is required to practice in the profession. You must meet the TRBWA literacy and numeracy proficiency requirements prior to graduation for teacher registration in Western Australia. Further information is available at **trb.wa.gov.au**.
