Dear Parishioners, Here are some few highlights from our Parish Mission Day 3: Fr Jim Sichko spoke on "Leadership"

How to be a good leader at school, in your family, in Church, in workplace, in the community, etc. He encouraged everyone to follow the examples of Jesus who was a good leader and guide. There are six steps how to be a good leader:

- 1. **Internal anchor**: Jesus has God the Father as His internal anchor. We must make Jesus in the Eucharist as our internal anchor as Catholics. With Jesus as the anchor of our lives we are not going to be uprooted by the troubles of this life.
- 2. Attitude of Gratitude: a good leader always has an attitude of gratitude; a good leader always shows gratitude. Jesus, always gave thanks to God the Father. Give thanks, say thank you.
- 3. Keep the Vision: a good leader always keeps the vision. Jesus kept his focus on the vision, even when many people tried to dissuade him from where he was meant to be.
- 4. **Communicate the Vision:** a good leader keeps the vision but always communicates the vision. We are called to communicate things and share that people may not want to hear.
- 5. Willing to do the difficult things: Jesus was willing to do difficult things, including accepting a painful and a horrible death for our sake. As Christians, as Catholics, we are all called to do difficult things. As Christian Parents you are the primary catechists of your children, when your child was baptised you accepted the responsibility to bring the child up in the faith. As parents you can do this by showing good example and making your home a domestic church.
- 6. **Small things matter:** Small things matter to Jesus. No leader depends on their followers. God bless you, Fr Joseph
