Stick and Twig Letters



Nature Craft



The basics of this craft are cut out a letter shape, fill with cut-down-to-size sticks.

## Supplies:

- Assorted sticks and twigs from around the garden
- Piece of cardboard (cereal box is ideal)
- Craft glue
- Scissors
- Pruning Shears

## Directions:

1. Wander around your yard collecting a selection of small and varied twigs. Not too thick as you will need

to be able to cut them with scissors. Hint: straighter sticks are easier to use.

- 2. Trace the chosen letter, (eg: S as in Sue) onto your cardboard.
- 3. Carefully cut your letter out.
- 4. Set up with another cereal box as my workspace protector. Using white tacky glue, select and trim your sticks as needed with pruning shears. Start at the top and test fit a few pieces at a time before actually gluing down the sticks. Once that set was sticky enough to move on, repeat the process.
- 5. To finish , glue it to a heavy sheet of coloured card.
