## **Year 7 2025 - Orientation Day, Induction Day and Parent Information Session**

My name is Mr Mathew Asphar, and I will have the honour of being Head of Year 7 in 2025.

I am writing to inform you that we will have a few important events over the coming months, as part of your child's transition to Year 7.

### **Orientation Day | Friday 22 November 2024**

The first event is a compulsory **Orientation Day** for all Year 7 students. This will be held on Friday 22 November 2024. The purpose of this day is to familiarise students with the policies and processes of the College, meet some key members of staff including the Principal, Deputy Principals and Head of Year, and complete a range of activities across the campus with both staff and student leaders from Year 10.

For *Orientation Day*, please have your child at the Auditorium at 8am so that the sign-in process can commence promptly. Students will need to wear their current school sports uniform, and bring with them a hat, water bottle and recess. A schedule and more communication will follow as the day approaches.

### **Induction Day | Monday 3 February 2025**

The second event is a compulsory *Induction Day*, which will be held on Monday 3 February 2025, before Term 1 officially commences. It is a half-day, and students will need to bring their core subject equipment, stationery, drink bottle and recess in their school bag. Students are expected to wear the full summer uniform. Normal school rules regarding hair, make-up, and jewellery will apply and will be communicated prior to this.

On *Induction Day*, please arrive with your child at the Auditorium by 8:15am and pick them up at 12:30pm. Once students arrive, they will be greeted and shown to their Pastoral Care group seating area in the auditorium. The schedule for the day will be sent out closer to the date.

Included in this morning, will be a Parent Information Session. The session will begin at 8:40am in the Auditorium. This brief, yet important, session will allow us to reintroduce and introduce key staff, provide information about parent communication portals, and share key details to ensure a seamless start to the year.

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## **Subjects**

Lastly, you will also receive communication from the College regarding the subjects your child will be completing next year. Along with our 4 Course Subjects (Mathematics, English, Science, and Humanities and Social Sciences), Year 7 students will also complete Taste Tester courses throughout the year.
