The Bachelor of Engineering Technology also provides a pathway to the Bachelor of Engineering Honours, where you can qualify as a specialist in environmental engineering, electrical and renewable energy, or industrial control and automation, depending on your interests and career goals. The Murdoch University Indigenous Engineering Pathway Scholarship will move with you, should you transfer to the Bachelor of Engineering Honours program.
