However, we will still take applications after this date for these courses, as we will hold late auditions in November.

<u>ECU's School of Business and Law</u> have released a new course: <u>Bachelor of Science (Exercise and Sports</u> <u>Science)/Bachelor of Commerce (Sport Business)</u> which is commencing Semester 1, 2019.

Employment opportunities

Potential career opportunities exist for managers within a range of global sport organisations and businesses, including the diverse areas of professional sport organisations, national and state sport associations, high performance sports clinics, health and wellness case management, private exercise, fitness, sport and rehabilitation franchise operations, personal training businesses, and elite and high performance sport organisations.

Students are required to complete three practicum placements through the duration of their course, totally 215 hours.

ECU's School of Nursing and Midwifery have changed the indicative ATAR for the Bachelor of Science (Nursing)/Bachelor of Science (Midwifery) from 80 to 75 for the 2019 admissions intake. Along with the ATAR change a new Special Admissions Requirement has now be added which is "All applicants are required to provide a personal statement. This statement must outline their understanding of the Registered Nurse's role and of a Registered Midwife's role, their reasons for wishing to undertake this course, and an outline of their plan for managing the workload". Students can upload their personal statement to their online application.
