



Premier's Reading Challenge Instructions





This is the PRC homepage. To enter books that have been read click on Student Reading Records.



Each book from the booklist has a PRC ID number which can be found on booklist. The ID number, Title and Author need to be entered.



Students can also read a MAXIMUM of 5 books of their choosing that are not on the list. To enter these books click on Add a Choice Book.
