- ▶ **2** Adults Surveyed

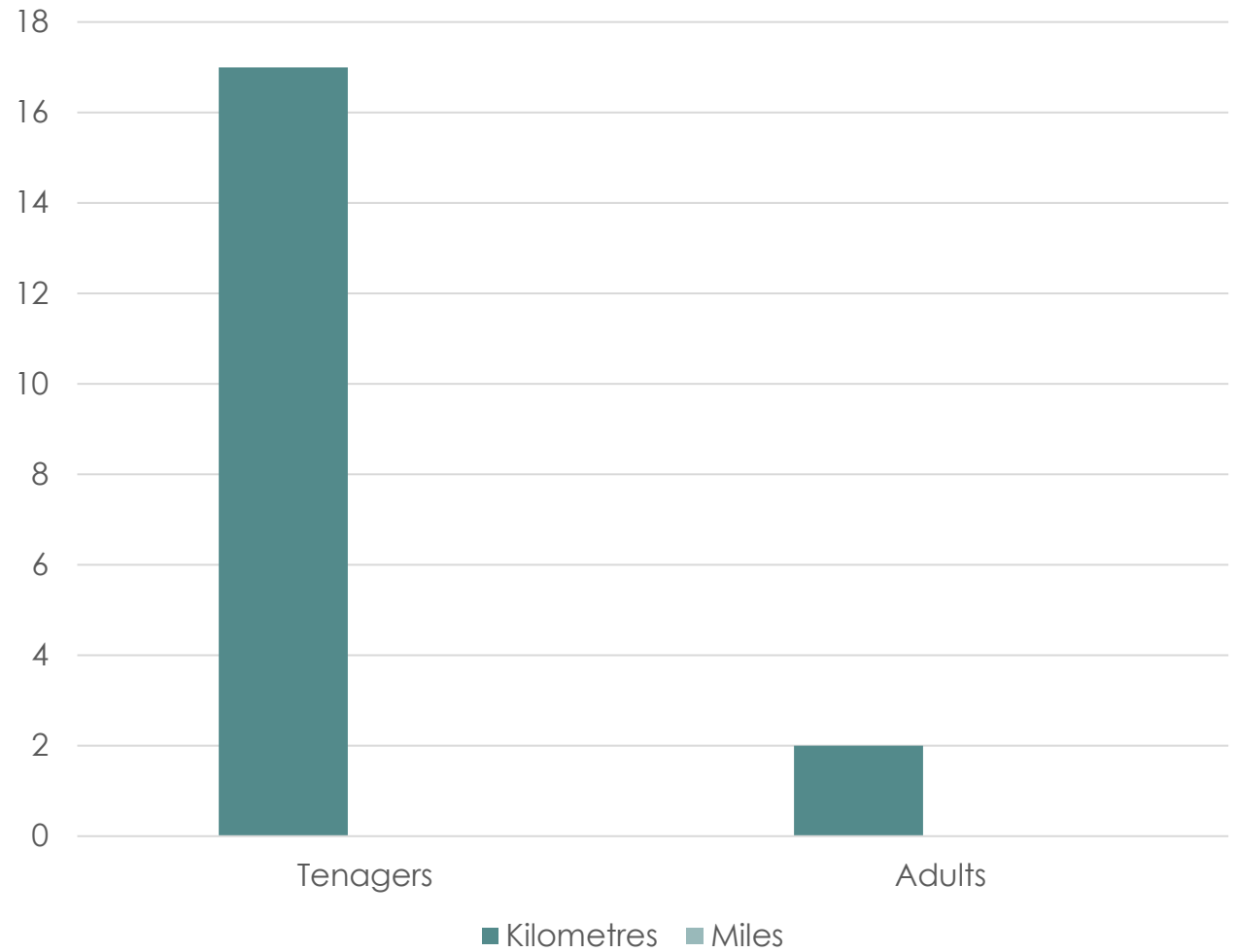

Question 1

“How far away is your house from the school?”

100% of teenagers and adults who answered the question said Kilometres



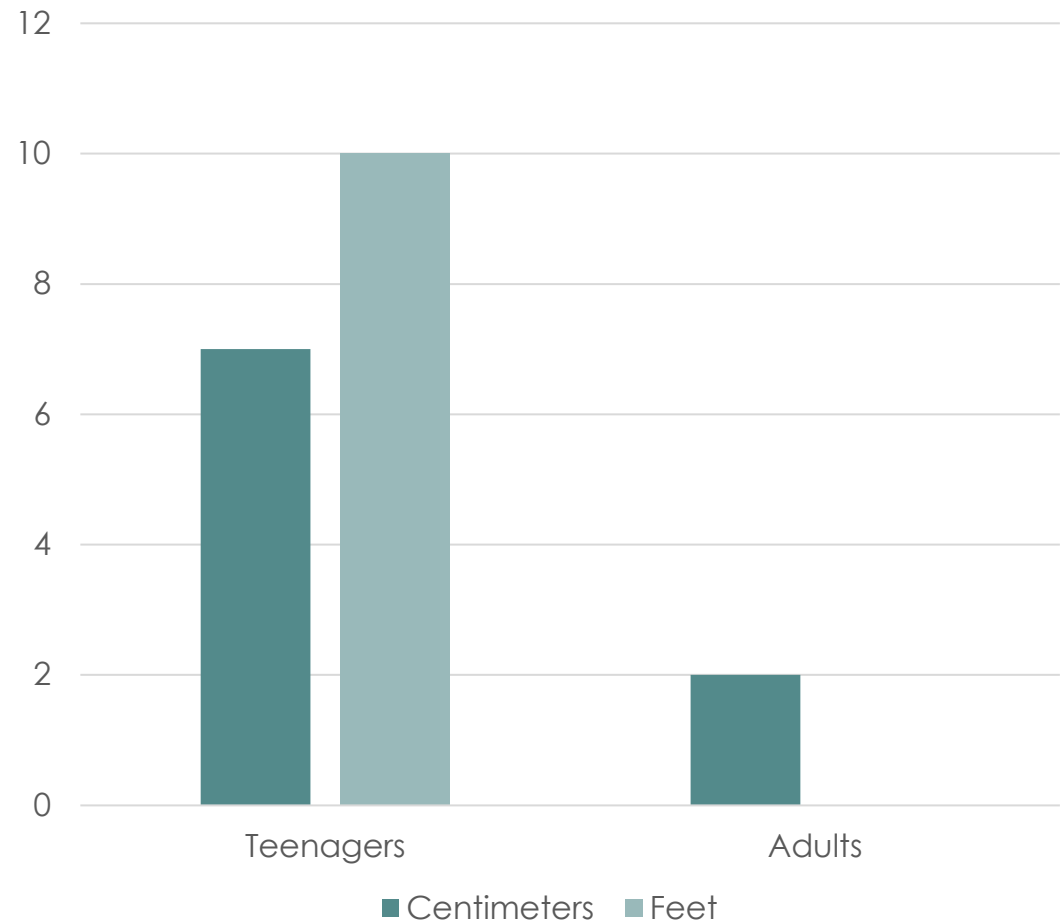
Question 2

“How Tall Are You?”

41% of teenagers who answered the question said centimetres.

59% of teenagers who answered the question said feet.

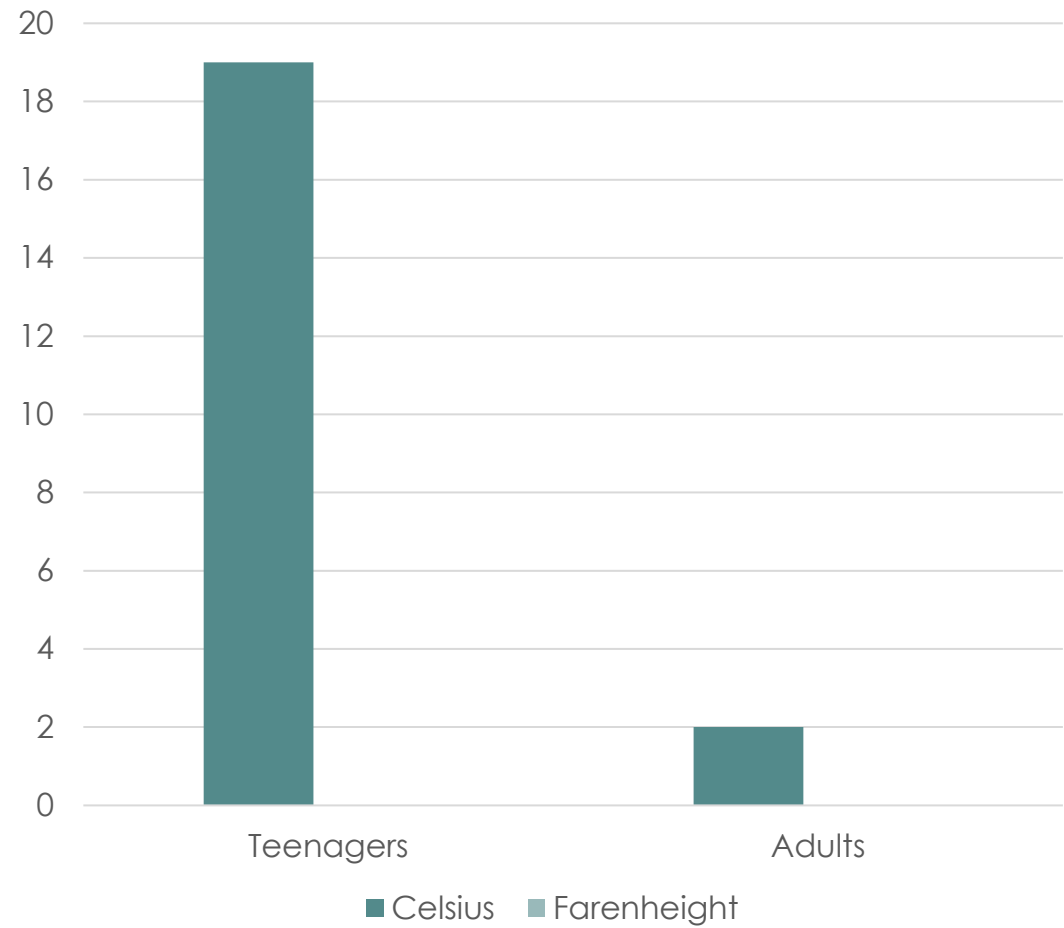
100% of adults who answered the question said centimetres.



Question 3

“What degrees is it today?”

100% of both teenagers and adults said Celsius.

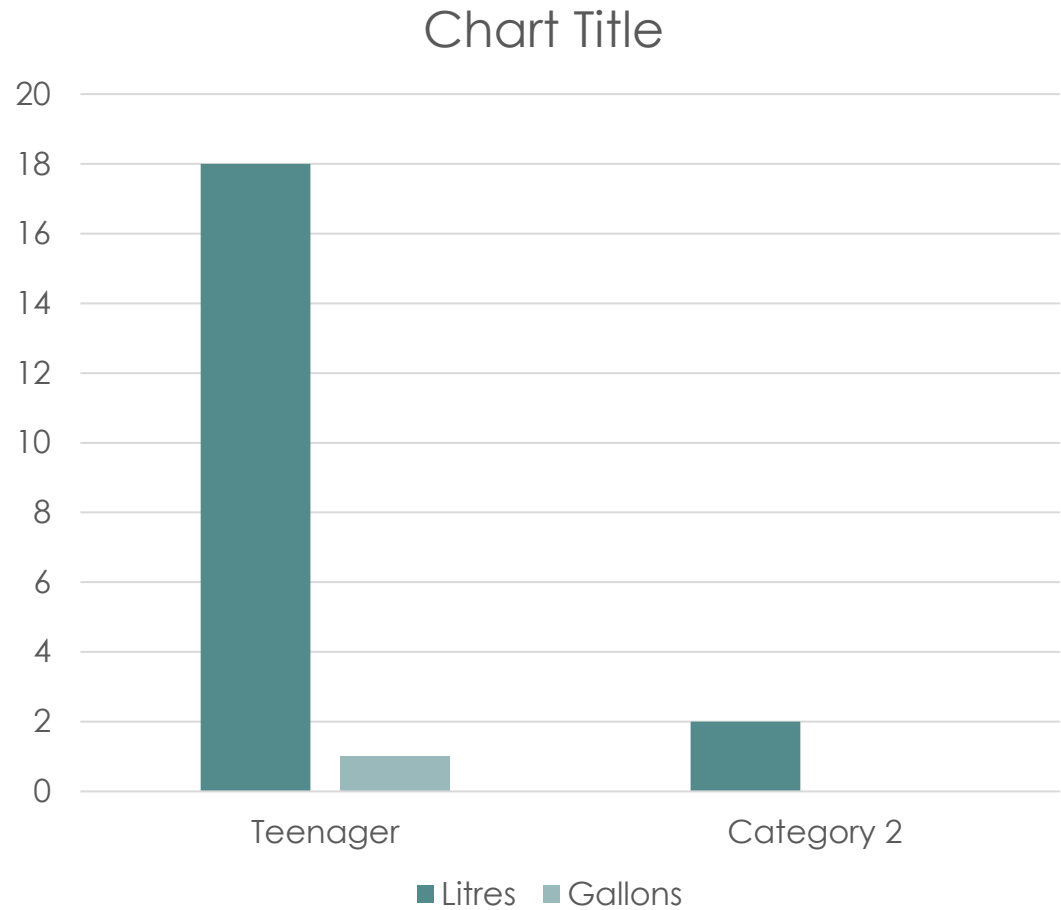


Question 4

“How big is your drink bottle?”

94% of teenagers said Liters
and 100% of adults also said
Liters.

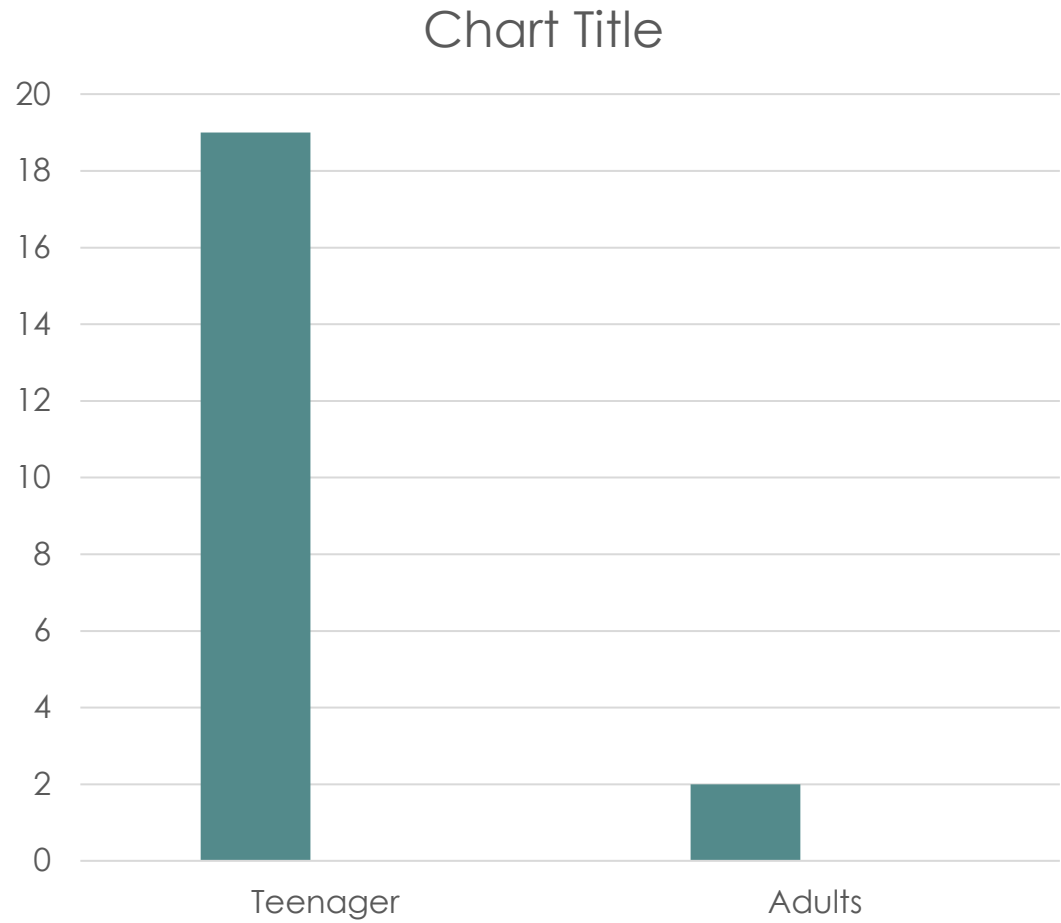
6% of teenagers said Gallons
