


# The Questions

100% of teenagers and adults who answered the question said Kilometres




"How Tall Are You?"

41% of teenagers who answered the question said centimetres.


59% of teenagers who answered the question said feet.

"What degrees is it today?"


100% of both teenagers and adults said Celsius.

94% of teenagers said Liters and 100% of adults also sad Litres.


6% of teenagers said Gallons
