

# LNPS PERSONAL PRESENTATION AND UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Lockleys North Primary School students take pride in their personal presentation as a way of supporting each other to develop a strong sense of identity and community. The LNPS uniform ensures consistency of presentation between students.

Our students are ambassadors of our school and, therefore, need to be mindful of enhancing its reputation. As such, whenever the school uniform is worn, it should be worn in its entirety and worn in accordance with these requirements. The wearing of the school uniform proudly identifies our students at all times.

## Formal LNPS School Uniform

The colours of the uniform are navy, light blue and white.

### The uniform consists of:

- LNPS polo shirt, short and long sleeve
- LNPS sports t-shirt - house colour (sports events only)
- Senior (Year 6) polo shirts and windcheaters
- LNPS hoodie / zip jacket
- LNPS winter jacket (special order)
- Navy hats and beanies
- Navy shorts, skorts, trousers

## Year 6 (Senior) Uniform


Our Year 6 Senior Students are required to wear the LNPS formal school uniform.

As a Senior at LNPS, they also have the option to wear custom (Seniors) polo shirts and jumpers.

## General Uniform Information

At LNPS students take pride in our school. The LNPS uniform policy ensures consistency of presentation between students. The following uniform requirements apply to both winter and summer options:

- No other visible branding or logos other than LNPS school logo.
- **Length of Uniform** - shorts and skirts must be worn no shorter than just above the knee or mid-thigh.
- Bike shorts are to be knee length, just above the knee or mid-thigh.
- Sleeves of polo shirts, sports tops and legs of shorts must not be rolled in order to shorten the length of the uniform item.

## Footwear

- Sensible, comfortable closed footwear (sneakers preferred).
- No thongs or surf sandals for Health and Safety reasons.
- Plain socks or stockings (including sports socks).

## Casual Day Dress Expectations

On casual days students can wear clothing appropriate with the theme of casual day. However, students are still expected to follow sun safety rules when outside and meet our personal presentation requirements.

With this in mind, students should ensure their casual dress adheres to the following:

- Shorts, skirts and dresses should be no shorter than just above the knee length
- Midriffs must not be shown
- No shoestring strap singlets or strapless tops are to be worn.

## Jewellery

- Discreet jewellery only for Health & Safety reasons
- No visible piercing other than earlobes
- Studs or sleeper earrings only for Health & Safety reasons
- Necklaces and bracelets to be securely fitted and not excessively loose to ensure safety and prevent loss.
- No smart watches and other wearable devices that can send/receive calls and messages or connect to the internet ([see Student use of mobile phones and personal devices policy](#))

### ***Jewellery exception items:***

- A medical alert bracelet and/or necklace which must be worn at all times.

## Make up

- No makeup including eye make up, eyelash extensions/false eyelashes.
- No coloured nail polish or false long nails (eg Acrylic/SNS etc) for Health and Safety reasons.

## Hats and Beanies

A **no-hat no no-play** policy is implemented throughout the year. Students who do not wear hats are required to sit in designated shaded areas during recess and lunch.

Navy school bucket hat with school logo and reversible house colour. Other suitable navy hats include bucket, wide-brimmed and legionnaire.

Our LNPS navy beanies are allowed to be worn in winter.



## Hair Accessories

Hair ribbons and headbands must be school colours of navy, white or light blue.

## Exemption

The Department for Education states that Principals may exempt students from the Dress Code Policy upon written request from the parents, on the following grounds:

- Religious
- Cultural or ethnic
- New student (time to purchase)
- Itinerant students
- Financial hardship (support can be negotiated)
- When there is a genuine medical or family reason for not wearing uniform, the school should be informed in writing.

**All students are required to wear clothing consistent with the school's uniform at all times.**

**Leadership will inform class teachers of the names of those children who have written exemptions.**
