

Suburban Rail Loop and Suburban Connect

Suburban Rail Loop will deliver a 90km rail line linking every major train service from the Frankston Line to the Werribee Line via Melbourne Airport, better connecting Victorians to jobs, retail, education, health services and each other. SRL East, also known as 'Suburban Connect' is the first package that will be delivered. The Suburban Connect consortium, comprising CPB Contractors, ACCIONA and Ghella, will be constructing a 16-kilometre section of the project's twin tunnels, including tunnelling between Cheltenham and Glen Waverley, 55 safety cross passages between the tunnels, station boxes at Clayton and Monash. Suburban Connect is proud of the opportunity this presents – not only to build one of the largest tunnelling projects in Australia, but also to have a positive and lasting social impact on the communities we're working in and amongst.

Purpose for Activities Day

Targeting Year 10 and 11's in 2024 to be looking at SBAT positions for 2025 to get a head start on their careers and the year 12's who will be looking to kick off their University and Tafe Studies or straight into employment in 2025.
