Clyde Road, Berwick – Works in your area this March

The Victorian Government is removing 17 dangerous level crossings, including the one at Clyde Road as part of a \$16 billion investment to upgrade the Pakenham line that will improve safety, reduce congestion and allow more trains to run more often.

Major works are underway to build the new Clyde Road underpass and improve local connections. Throughout March we'll continue foundation works for the new road underpass and install and relocate underground services in the area.

What to expect

- Lane closures, reduced speed limits and traffic management along Clyde Road and local roads
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours to help you move safely through the area
- Construction workers, heavy vehicle activity and moderate noise and vibrations
- Micro tunnelling near Buchanan Park to prepare for drainage installation
- Tree removal south of Enterprise Avenue to facilitate drainage works.

Car parking changes

To allow works to progress on the new Berwick Station bus interchange, there will be changes to car parking in the area.

- **From early March to mid 2021** up to 170 car parking spaces in Berwick Station will be closed. Additional car spaces are available at Officer and Beaconsfield stations.
- **From mid-March until 2022** the Pick Up and Drop Off zone and taxi bay will be closed on the northern side of Berwick Station.
- **From late March to late 2021** some public car parking spaces will be closed on Clyde Road near the Berwick Skate Park.

Night works

Some out of hours works may be required throughout March. We'll notify impacted residents ahead of night works and minimise impacts where possible.
