At the designated time, parents access the link on the email and 'knock'. The teacher will then admit you into the meeting when they are able.

Meetings are scheduled for 5 minutes for Years 7 to 10 and 8 minutes for Years 5 and 6.

The Move to Online Meetings

The move to online bookings follows the very positive feedback received from parents last year during COVID-19 including:

- Less stress in having to travel to the College and find parking at the end of a workday.
- Being able to conduct meetings at home alleviated the issue of caring for younger children

- Online offered greater flexibility and allowed multiple participants to log in from different locations

The most significant feedback was how the quality of the meetings significantly improved by not having to contend with background noise in the gymnasium.

Parents commented on how they felt they were able to have a quality conversation with teachers rather than feel like they were rushed and always conscious that other parents were hovering whilst they wait their turn.

The College always knew of the issues of conducting interviews in the gymnasium and each year had to contend with the same negative feedback from parents with limited opportunity to resolve them.

Overall, the feedback was the experience online was very positive and if COVID-19 did bring some benefits it was learning to do things in new and better ways.

I understand some parents may prefer face to face and online is not their preference.
