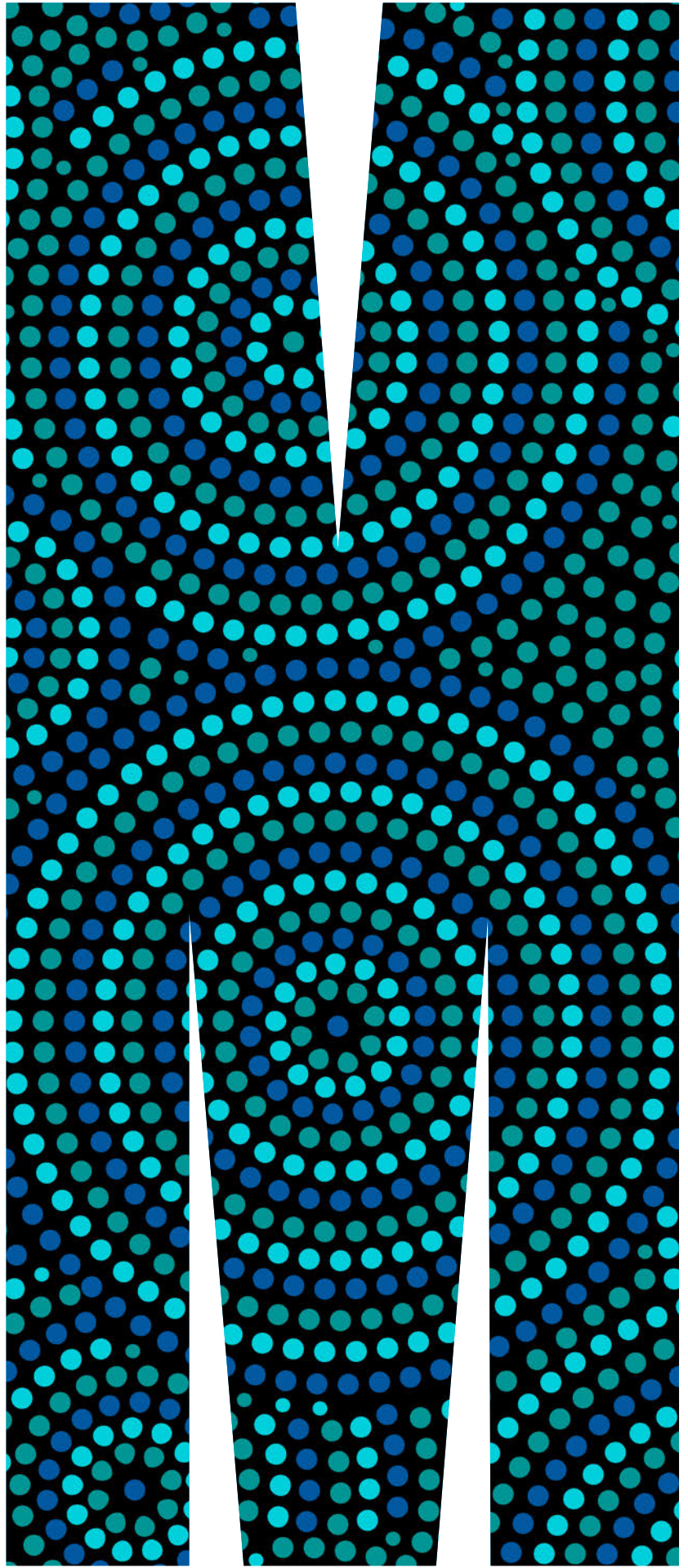

EXPERIENCE MONASH INDIGENOUS SUMMER CAMP

From 4 - 8 December, 2018 Monash University invites you to participate in the *Experience Monash Indigenous Summer Camp*.

The 2018 summer camp aims to provide Indigenous students from year 10 – 12* with an in-depth insight into university life, while focusing on team-building, motivation, meeting new people, confidence-building, and health and wellbeing.



*Must be at least 16 years old at the time of the camp.

Over three days students have the opportunity to experience the following:

- Stories, advice and mentoring from our current students
- Cultural activities
- Careers and course advice
- Student support advice
- Keynote speeches from community leaders, academics and other inspiring people
- Interactive faculty activities and workshops
- Monash Sport activities
- Staying on campus
- 10 pin bowling, sport activities and more



The key point for Emily Estcourt prior to commencing at Monash was at the first Experience Monash Indigenous Summer Camp. Until then, tertiary study was not something she had considered.

The camp gave her a taste of life on campus and introduced her to a range of opportunities, particularly the Monash Indigenous Scholarship for Achievement and Equity. The scholarship soon turned university education into a reality for her.

Emily completed a Bachelor of Arts, with a major in Indigenous Studies and a minor in Behavioural Studies. She credits the Monash Yulendj Indigenous Engagement Unit for helping her through her course, providing clear course guidance and keeping students active and involved in the University community. Emily now has a full time position as the HR Operations Analyst for Viva Energy Australia.

She has since returned to the summer camp as a mentor, where she uses her course knowledge to guide new participants. She is also a student ambassador and an alumni member of Career Trackers Indigenous Internship program.
