The **Lasallian Volunteer Program 2026** offers an unforgettable 11-month journey of **Faith, Service, and Community**. Step into a year that challenges you, shapes you, and connects you with Lasallians across **Australia, New Zealand and Papua New Guinea** — serving others and growing in purpose.

✳️ What's new in 2026?

The 2026 program has been refreshed to strengthen the volunteer experience:

- Volunteers arrange travel to and from **Sydney** for onboarding/training (January) and debrief (December).
- **Food and accommodation** are provided throughout placements.
- **Travel between Sydney and your placement** is covered by the program.
- **Weekly stipends** vary depending on the community placement.

📍 2026 Community Placements

Community	Overview	Positions
Balgo, WA	A remote Aboriginal community in the Kimberley. Volunteers at <i>Luurnpa Catholic School</i> support education, youth engagement, and outreach alongside the Wirrimanu people — a powerful cultural and faith experience requiring flexibility and resilience.	2–3 Volunteers (open to all)
De La Salle College, Mangere, Auckland	A vibrant South Auckland secondary school of 1,100 boys, many from Pacific Islander backgrounds. Volunteers mentor students, support school life, and share community with the Brothers.	2 Male Volunteers
La Salle College, Middle Swan, WA	Perth-based school with a proud Lasallian heritage. Volunteers assist Aboriginal boarding students from remote WA communities in class and at the hostel, supporting learning and weekend activities.	2 Volunteers
La Salle Technical College, Port Moresby	A Lasallian school offering young people a second chance at education and trade skills. Volunteers assist in classes, workshops, and community life.	1 Male Volunteer, open only for local applicants

🧭 How to Prepare

Before applying, please have ready:

- Electronic copies of your **passport, driver's licence**, and any relevant certificates.
- Details for **three referees**: one *spiritual* (e.g. Church or Lasallian contact), one *character* (non-parent family member or friend), and one *employer/volunteer supervisor* for a phone reference.
- A **parent or caregiver endorsement** (see attached letter for details).
- A short reflection on your **motivation** and the gifts you hope to bring to community life.
