## We look forward to celebrating your child's Reconciliation with your family. Please find below information and reminders to help our celebrations run smoothly.

#### Arrival Time

• Please ensure you arrive at least 10 minutes before the celebration begins.

#### Duration

• We anticipate the celebration of Reconciliation will be approximately 1 hour.

#### What to bring

- Children should bring their stoles.
- A pin will be on their chair, to be pinned to their stoles when they arrive.

#### Dress and attire

• Candidates are to wear what you would consider 'special-occasion' clothes.

#### Stoles

- Reconciliation candidates have been supplied with a stole to wear during the celebration. The stole is draped like a scarf.
- Your stole can include a symbol of Reconciliation (eg. cross, prayer hands) and dates for each Sacrament your child has received (Baptism and now Reconciliation). The size of the lettering and symbols is up to you.
- The stole can be decorated simply and beautifully with any material (eg. embroidery, fabric paints, quilt patch, appliqué, cut felt pieces)

#### Photography

- A staff member will take photos throughout the Reconciliation. These photos will be provided to families.
- We ask families to remember that the liturgy is a sacred and special time. Please ensure any photos or videos do not disturb the reverence of the liturgy. The sacrament of Reconciliation is a private moment. Please do not take photos during this time.
- There will be an opportunity for families to take group and individual photos at the end of the celebration.

#### Seating arrangements

- Seating will be allocated to candidates and families.
- All candidates can have five guests in total.
- A place card for each of the candidates will be in the aisle seat.
- There will be a small number of extra seats available on the night.

#### **Receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation**

- At the time of Reconciliation, a member of staff will indicate when it is your child's time to receive the Sacrament. At this time you will walk with your child to the priest and introduce yourself and your child and then return to your seats.
- Once your child is introduced to the Priest, he/she sits down and begins to participate in the Sacrament.
- When students have received their blessing they will light a candle with their family/carers and then return to their seats, where they can say a silent prayer, reflecting on their Sacrament.

#### **Presentation Masses**

• As part of celebrating the Sacraments with the Parish community, families are asked to attend a Presentation Mass, prior to the celebration of Reconciliation. At this Mass, the Priest will acknowledge your child and the parishioners will be asked to pray for them as they take this next step in the faith journey.
