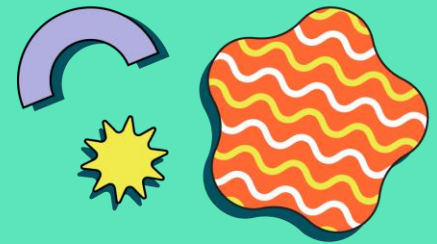


# Newsletter



## A message from your Coordinator

Hello, and welcome to this week's newsletter. This week we will be learning about Indigenous culture during Reconciliation Week (29<sup>th</sup> of May to 2<sup>nd</sup> of June); throughout the week we will be learning some Indigenous art and craft activities like designing your own creating your own story stones, learning about the different Dreamtime symbols, and creating art with natural materials, and learning about some group games like the sporting game of Kai.

Also, during week 6, we will be practicing our emergency drills, we will be practicing 3 drills. One drill will be in case of a fire, one will be on a lockdown, and one will be in case of a medical emergency. During these drills, we practice what to do as well as have a group discussion about what to do next and when we know the emergency is over.
