Introduction to the First Peoples in Wyndham

The Kulin Nation refers to an alliance of five Aboriginal tribes in south central Victoria. The collective traditional territory for the tribes of the Kulin Nation extends around Port Phillip and Western Port, up into the Great Dividing Range and the Loddon and Goulburn River valleys. Below is a listing of the language groups and the tribes associated with that language group.

- Woiwurrung (Woy-wur- rung) The Wurundjeri People
- Boonrwrung (Bun-er- rung) The Bunurong or Boonerwrung People
- Wathaurrung (Wath-er-rung) The Wathaurong People
- Daungwurrung (Tung-ger- rung) The Taungurong People
- Dja Dja Wrung (Jar-Jar wrung) The Dja Dja Wurrung or Jaara People.

FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION INFORMATION

What is physical violence?

Kicking, hitting, slapping, punching, strangling, biting, pushing, pulling, shoving, throwing, objects, grabbing you to stop you from leaving of to force you to go somewhere.

What is emotional abuse?

Name calling, insulting, constant criticizing, screaming, threatening, to hurt you or your children or to have your children taken away, preventing you from seeing family or friends, telling what to wear.

What is financial abuse?

Denying you access to your earnings or financial information, preventing you from working, denying you money for necessities, deliberately trying to get you fired by harassing you at work.

What is sexual abuse?

Rape, forcing you to have sex, pressuring you to perform sexual acts when you don't want to, unwanted rough or violent sexual activity, sexual comments, kissing or touching.
