RELIGION	We are moving into the season of Advent and the preparation of Jesus' birth. Students learn that Advent is a time of waiting and preparing for the birth of the Son of God at Christmas. They explore the writings of the Old Testament people and reflect on how these teachings are relevant in their own lives today.	
SPELLING	We continue to teach spelling through explicit, direct instruction using the PhOrMeS program. We give students knowledge about the origins of words (etymology) and also how words are broken up into parts of meaning (morphology), as well as sounds. This can then be used to understand spoken and written language to a high level and help our students use sophisticated vocabulary within their writing. We will finish up the year studying the Latin base - 'stru/struct' meaning 'build.'	

	 Public Speaking: Students have been doing a wonderful job on their public speaking speeches and continue to use the skills they have developed. Explanation Texts: We consolidate our learning on Text Writing structures, looking at Multiple Paragraph Outlines (MPO) to plan for a text. Students will publish final explanation texts using the expected text features and language features. Reading: Students are exploring Space Systems. They are reading texts about the The Moon from the Earth and Indigenous astronomy. Students will also continue to practise their fluency and accuracy of their reading; as a class and also in Paired Fluency reading sessions. The information from these texts will be used in their Explanation Writing. 	
MATHS 12345 67890	Order of Operations We finish up the year reviewing the Order of Operations. Students will find unknown values in equations involving brackets using the properties of numbers and operations.	
	We finish up the year exploring the social science of Economics. Students will study how people use resources to respond to needs versus wants, and make decisions based on these ideas. Students will explore the concepts of production, distribution, and consumption of goods and services.
