During Spelling Mastery, I will go to a **different classroom** and learn with a **different teacher and different classmates**. These are the spelling teachers:























There may be students from my year level or other year levels. My new spelling teacher knows my spelling goals and is there to help me.

I walk to my class quietly and calmly. This means no talking in the hallways. Extra teachers and leadership will be in the hall to check that everyone is moving quietly.






When I get to my Spelling Mastery class, my book will be on the table. I find my book and sit at that spot. My teacher has chosen where I will sit.
