## Works alert – Bridge foundations and rail signalling works

Works are continuing on the Maroondah Highway level crossing removal project with strict health and safety protocols in place. The health and safety of our workers and the community will remain our key priority as we undertake works on the Maroondah Highway level crossing removal project. We will continue to follow the directions of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) as we safely complete works on this project.

This works alert provides an overview of the construction activities you may notice from **26 April 2021**.

## Changes to the way you travel

To safely complete works, there will be some planned changes to the way you travel. Buses will intermittently replace trains on the Lilydale line between **Mon 10 May and Tues 25 May 2021**. Please see below table for details.

Buses replacing trains between	Dates
Ringwood and Lilydale	Monday 10 May to Thursday 13 May, from 8.30pm to last service each night
Camberwell, Lilydale and Belgrave	8.30pm Friday 14 May to last service Sunday 16 May
Blackburn, Lilydale and Belgrave	Monday 17 May to Wednesday 19 May, from 8.30pm to last service each night
Ringwood and Lilydale	10.30pm to last service Thursday 20 May and Tuesday 25 May

Road disruptions	Planned travel changes
Maroondah Highway (service road)	The Maroondah Highway service road (Bunnings side) will have intermittent closures at the exit to Maroondah Highway. Traffic management will be in place to safely assist motorists on their journey.
William Street East and West	There will be intermittent closures on William Street East between Maroondah Highway and John Street. William Street West remains open to traffic.

## Upcoming works

### John Street and William Street East and West

- Piling works, bridge foundation works, station services and concrete demolition works will continue in various locations within the rail corridor at the corner of John Street and between William Street East and West.
- Work to install drainage will be carried out on William Street East and West until Saturday 10 May. During this period there will be changes to the way you access some local roads.
- Large rigs, cranes, trucks and vibratory rollers will be in operation during this period. There will be an increase in construction noise and vibration while these works are carried out.

## Maroondah Highway

- Bridge foundation works will continue on the corner of Maroondah Highway and William Street East and West.
- Work to install drainage will take place on Maroondah Highway until Saturday 10 May. During this period there will be changes to the way you access some local roads.
- There will be large rigs and an increase in trucks in operation, as well as an increase in construction noise during this period.

## What to expect

- While most works are planned to be carried out during standard construction hours (7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm Saturday), some works may be required outside of this.
- The delivery of construction equipment and machinery may occur outside of standard construction hours due to road restrictions during daytime hours. We anticipate any disruption associated with these deliveries will be low-level.
- You will notice an increase in construction vehicle movements, noise, vibration and activity in the area.
- Intermittent road and lane closures on John Street, Maroondah Highway and William Street East and West.
- Traffic management will be in place across various locations to safely assist road users and pedestrians to their destination.
