We're busy removing level crossings

As part of Victoria's Big Build, we're making the Frankston Line level crossing free by removing all 27 of the dangerous and congested level crossings by 2029. We're building 17 new stations, improving safety, reducing congestion and allowing more trains to run more often.

The Glen Huntly Level Crossing Removal Project will remove two level crossings at Neerim Road and Glen Huntly Road by lowering the train line into a trench, as well as building a new station at Glen Huntly.

The new station will feature lowered platforms that improve safety and accessibility for locals. It will also provide better connections between public transport, shops and community spaces.

These two dangerous and congested level crossings have been fast-tracked for removal, with early construction works underway to remove the boom gates by 2023 and finish the job in 2024 – one year ahead of schedule.

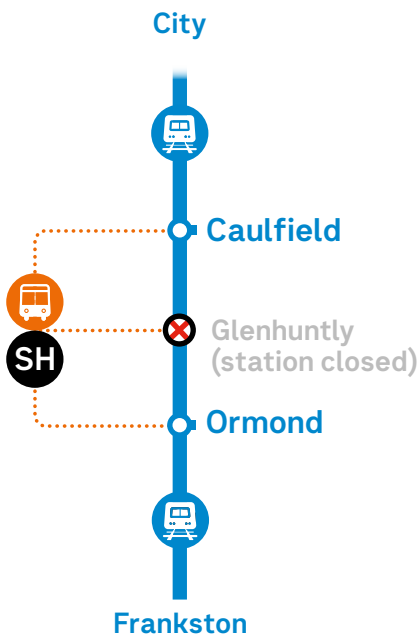
Shuttle bus service

Glenhuntly Station closure shuttle service

From **8.30pm Friday 31 March to early August**, Frankston Line trains will not stop at the closed Glenhuntly Station.

From **Monday 3 April** a shuttle bus will operate between Caulfield and Ormond to connect you to Frankston Line trains.

Shuttle buses will depart from the existing replacement bus stops on Grange Road.





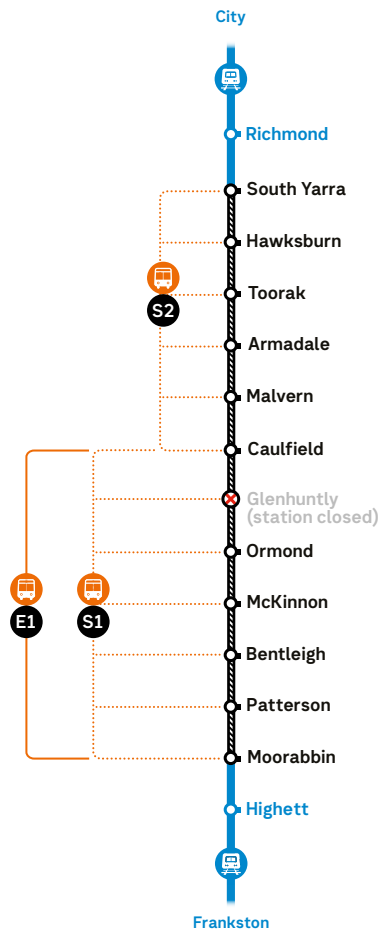
Buses replace trains

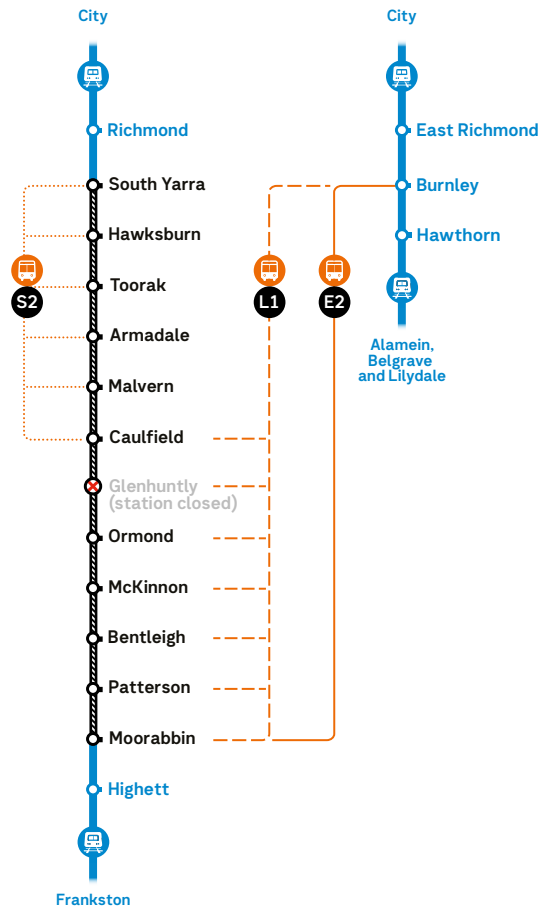

Buses will replace Route 67 trams at stops along Glen Huntly Road, between:

Travelling on a replacement bus

Accessibility

Most train replacement buses will be low-floor models to assist passengers.

If you need help or cannot board a replacement bus, please contact PTV prior to travelling on **1800 800 007** or speak to our staff at the bus stop for alternative transport to be arranged at no cost.

Bikes and pets

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.

Ticketing and station facilities

While the station is closed, station facilities and myki readers will not be available.

You should touch on and off at Caulfield and Ormond stations. New myki card purchases or myki top ups can be made at Caulfield or Ormond stations.

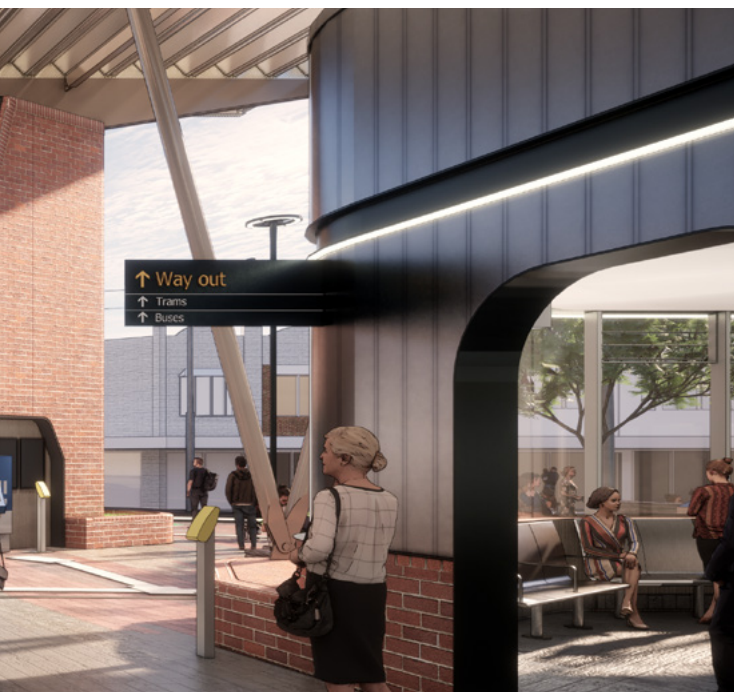
