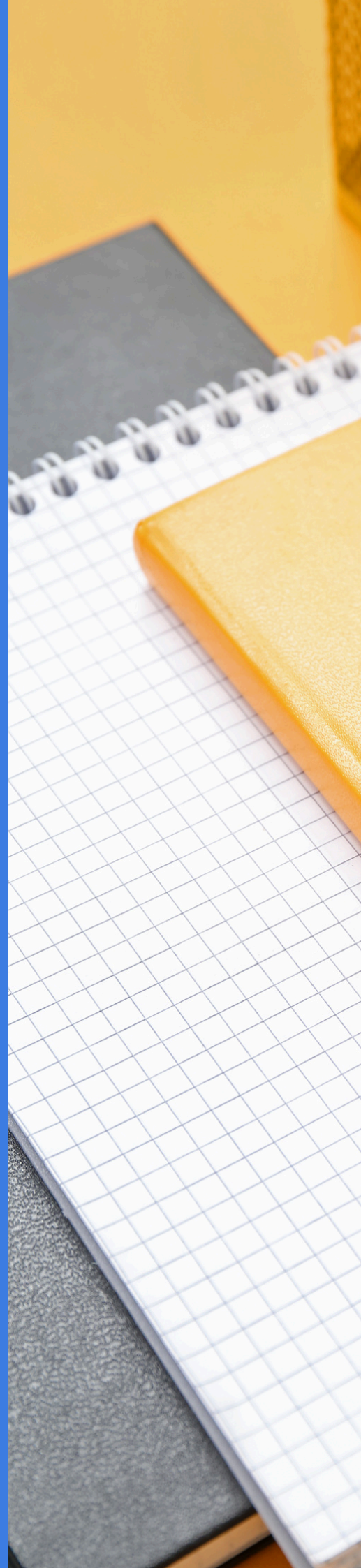

# What is early entry?

## **YOU APPLY EARLIER IN THE YEAR**

It really is just what it sounds like - some universities and Tertiary Admissions Centres (TACs) have programs that allow you to apply earlier than normal. You could receive an offer before the main offer rounds, giving you peace of mind as you head into your final year of school.

## **YOU CAN STILL APPLY THE 'NORMAL' WAY**

You can apply for early entry and also apply through the normal application process. Why? Basically, it gives you more options to choose from. Rather than applying through one process and hoping you get an offer, you can instead double your chances.

## **NOT ALL PROGRAMS THAT OPEN EARLY GIVE YOU AN EARLY OFFER**

Sometimes certain courses or universities have early application dates (think things like medicine or teaching), but this doesn't always mean you'll be getting your offer early. This is usually because these courses are competitive and get lots of applications, so the unis need extra time to process them all.

In this guide, we only cover programs that will allow you to receive an offer before the main offer rounds that usually happen in December and January.



# Is early entry for me?

## IF YOU...

- Get good marks
- Have sporting achievements
- Are recommended by your school
- Are an artist or musician
- Are active in your community
- Are a rural applicant
- Have leadership experience
- Have been disadvantaged

## EARLY ENTRY COULD BE FOR YOU

The selection board will look at a combination of factors, including your results, awards or achievements, letters of recommendation, auditions, portfolios, and more to decide if they want to make you an offer.

You may still have time to improve your application and increase your chances of securing a place, so it's a good idea to keep nurturing your extra-curricular and community activities as well as your school work throughout the year.

Every program is different with its own criteria, so check that you meet the eligibility requirements before you start your application. If not, either find another program or apply through the traditional pathway.



# Early entry vs alternative entry

Early entry can technically be considered a form of alternative entry, but they don't always mean the same thing. Here are some of the key differences:

## EARLY ENTRY

This is when you submit an application and receive an offer for a course before the main offer rounds at the end of the year. Early entry is often (but not always) merit-based, for students who stand out above the crowd with things like:

- Principal's recommendation
- Academic results
- Leadership or community engagement
- Other achievements

## ALTERNATIVE ENTRY

These programs help you get into university even if you didn't get the ATAR you wanted, didn't receive an offer for your chosen course, or didn't complete Year 12. Rather than applying while still at school, you'll often be following one of these pathways after results have been released, or even a couple of years down the track.

Alternative entry programs include things like:

- Bridging and foundation courses
- Adjustment factors
- Equity and access schemes
- Internal transfers
- External transfers
- Specialised testing, e.g. STAT
- Portfolio applications
- Work or life experience pathways

# Not sure if you want to go to university?

## THAT'S TOTALLY OK

At the end of the day, university isn't for everyone, and it's wise to keep your options open as you approach the end of school.

Even if you're not sure about university, you can still apply for early entry programs.

That way, when you get your offers, you can make an informed decision about the available pathways. If you decide to start an apprenticeship or traineeship or to go straight into work instead, then at least you'll have had the power to choose.

There are loads of other great pathways that don't involve university, and you should always carefully consider if university is the right path for you.

If you're not sure where to start, make a time to speak with your Careers Advisor or Year Level Coordinator. They may be able to help you clarify your options.



# The application process

If you're thinking that you'd like an early offer, then you need to learn about the application process. It's not quick, especially if you're going to apply for more than one program, so be prepared to fill in a fair bit of paperwork.

The good news is that this is good practice for once you leave school and start applying for lots of different things, like jobs.

If you don't have a portfolio of your achievements, now is a good time to put one together. Start by collecting all your certificates and awards (everything counts at this stage), then make a list of all your achievements in order from newest to oldest.

You may need to get a copy of your reports and any recent assessment scores. Even though you won't need your ATAR right now, the universities still want to see how you are performing and may even use your current results to calculate a predicted ATAR.

They'll also be keen to see if you're ready for the extra challenge of university study, so you may need a letter of recommendation or even sit for an interview.

If you need a letter of recommendation, make sure you ask your referee with plenty of time left before the application deadline, as they are probably busy and it may take them a little while to draft the letter.



Just as every program has different dates, benefits, and eligibility criteria, each program also has a different application process. The good news is that there are some similarities across programs, so you can follow these steps to prepare.

### **STEP 1 - FIND PROGRAMS TO APPLY FOR**

Do you want to go to that university, and can you study the course you'd like there? Importantly, check if the program is still open for applications.

### **STEP 2 - CHECK IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE**

Do you have evidence of your achievements or proof you meet the eligibility criteria? If you're unsure, reach out to the university to check before you apply.

### **STEP 3 - GATHER THE PAPERWORK**

You'll need to fill in an application, and may need to supply supporting documents. If you need a recommendation from a teacher or principal, make sure you have that ready as well.

### **STEP 4 - APPLY TO THE RIGHT PLACE**

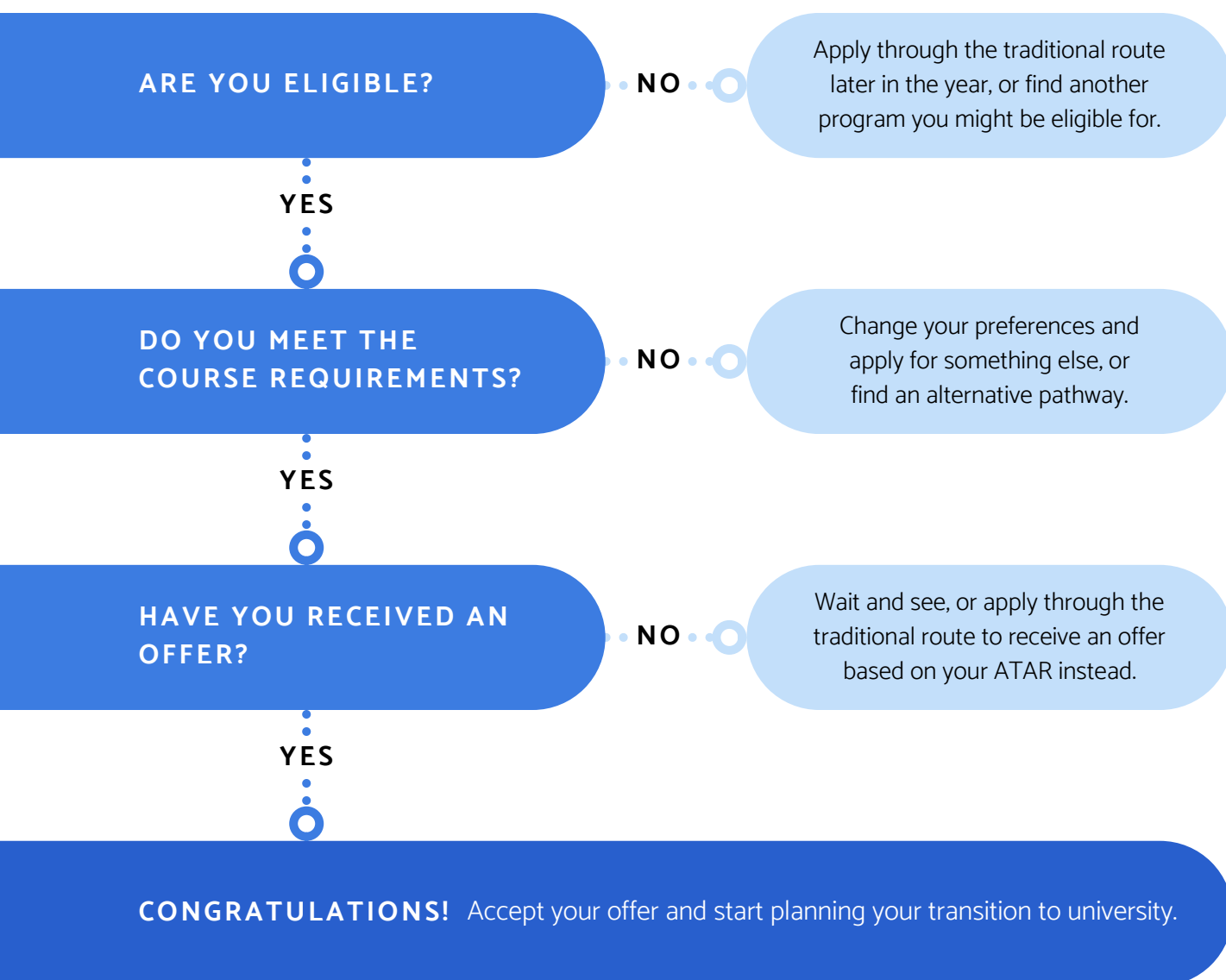
Do you need to apply directly to the university, through a TAC, or do both? Make sure you apply on time and pay any applicable fees.

### **STEP 5 - WAIT FOR YOUR OUTCOME**

It's a good idea to keep track of the offer release date(s), so you'll know when you can expect to hear the result of your application. Remember to check your emails regularly, including your junk folder.

# The offer flowchart

Once you've applied for an early entry program, the next thing to do is wait for offers to be released. Each university and program has different eligibility requirements and assessment processes, but here's a general idea of whether or not you can expect to receive an offer.



# Offer timelines

You might be wondering how long it will take for you to receive an offer after you submit your early entry application. Unfortunately, the answer is it's complicated.

## **OFFERS ARE MADE AT DIFFERENT TIMES**

Most early entry programs usually start releasing offers around September, but this is by no means a hard-and-fast rule. There has been a bit of change around early offers in the last few years, and the government is currently working to make each program more consistent across the board.

## **THERE MIGHT BE A BIT OF A WAIT**

With some programs opening as early as April, this means you might be waiting for a while until you find out the outcome of your application. Don't be discouraged if this is the case - make sure you double check the dates set by the university and keep an eye on your inbox in the meantime.

## **WHAT IF YOU DON'T HEAR BACK AT ALL?**

If the offer dates have come and gone and you still haven't heard anything, it's probably time to get in touch with the university to see what's going on. They should always contact you to let you know the outcome of your application, even if it's not successful.

### **ACU Guarantee**

The ACU Guarantee program offers eligible Year 12 students a pathway to ACU based on your Year 11 results. You may also enhance your entry score by including short personal statements.

You must be working towards receiving an ATAR or equivalent to be eligible, and offers are conditional on completing Year 12.

## **Campion College**

### **Early Offer Scheme**

If you are a Year 12 student, your offer will be conditional on receiving a minimum ATAR of 70. Interstate and IB equivalents are also accepted.

ATSIEP can be used to determine readiness for study and, if necessary, to provide advice on alternative methods of entry.

## UAC Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS)

You can receive one unconditional offer and one or more conditional offers. SRS is not available for all courses. Participating institutions may have different eligibility criteria.
