Numeracy

- Recognise, name and write numbers correctly
- Represent numbers in a variety of ways

- Revising learning and using feedback


Other KLAS

Literacy

- Read independently for 10 20 minutes
- Participate in class and group discussions
- Ask and answer questions about a story they have listened too
- Write a complete sentence on a given topic that includes a capital letter and a full stop
- Identify sight words and use strategies to sound them out
- Spell known high frequency words correctly
- For letters correctly and legibly
