Dear Parents and Carers

I am pleased to inform that in Week 3 of this Term, students in Years 5, 7 and 9 will be undertaking NAPLAN testing.

As happened last year, NAPLAN will be conducted ONLINE. This is in accordance with the Federal, state and territory education minister's agreement that all schools will gradually transition from the current paper-based NAPLAN to NAPLAN Online.

This will provide a better and more precise assessment that is more engaging for students.

What does NAPLAN assess?

NAPLAN assesses literacy and numeracy skills that students are learning through their regular school curriculum. On its own, NAPLAN is not a test that can be studied for and students are not expected to do so. You can support your child by reassuring them that NAPLAN is just one part of their school program, and by reminding them on the day to simply do their best.

Reminders

Charge PLDs

Students will need their PLDs to undertake testing. Please ensure your son charges his device the night before.

Earphones

Please remind your son to bring earphones as they are required to complete NAPLAN Online. For example, the spelling test includes audio delivery of words that students are required to type in.

Reporting of Results

Printed individual student reports will be sent to parents and carers by the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA).
