

Changing your preferences

If you've had a change of heart about what you want to study or where you'd like to go after you submitted your university application, it's not too late – you can still change your preferences.

Preferences are a term for the courses you want to apply for, listed in the order you'd like to study them.

At Study Work Grow we recommend that you list your dream course(s) first, some more realistic options next, and one safe option last. That way, you'll increase the odds of receiving at least one offer in the main round.

Listing the maximum number of possible preferences on your applications is also a good strategy. This will give you the best opportunity to receive at least one offer – or maybe more.

WHY CHANGE YOUR PREFERENCES?

There are lots of reasons you might like to change your preferences – here are just a few:

- Your ATAR was better than you expected
- Your ATAR wasn't as good as you had hoped for and you'd like to ensure you get offers
- You have had a change of heart about the ideal course or the best university for you
- You've discovered a course you didn't know about when you applied
- You've been advised that the prerequisites for a course you had on your list have changed
- The course you applied for has been dropped by the university
- You're reviewing your application and you realise that you didn't put your preferences in the right order

WHEN CAN YOU CHANGE YOUR PREFERENCES?

Most universities and TACs provide plenty of opportunities to change your preferences. After submitting your application and before you receive your final results, you can usually log into your application and adjust your preferences.

Take a look at the next page for exact dates.

Tip: If you've received an early conditional offer for one or more of the courses on your preferences, and you still want more offers during the main rounds, it's best to call the admission centre or institution directly if you're unsure about what to do next.

This information is correct at the time of publication (Oct 2023), but sometimes dates change for various reasons - so we recommend double-checking the cut offs for your chosen universities or courses directly with the TAC or institution.

Note: UTAS send out their main round of offers to Tasmanian students mid-December and to students in all other states/territories in January, so you may need to call and check with them when the last chance to change your preferences will be.

Don't stress if you don't get around to it, or if changing your preferences only becomes an issue after you've received your results. There will still be a period of time where you can make the change and ensure you receive the best offer for you.

MISSED THE CUT-OFF DATE?

If you miss the change of preference cut-offs for the first round, you'll usually still have the chance to change them again before the next offer round.

Once all the offer rounds are over and you have an offer but it's not for the course you really wanted, call up the university and find out what your options are. You might be able transfer internally if there are spaces left, or when places open up later in the year.

Most importantly, if you don't receive any offers at all, remember that you still have lots of options. Consider taking an alternative pathway instead. There are a number of choices available that could help get you into the course you'd like to study.

DO I HAVE TO CHANGE MY PREFERENCES?

If you get a higher ATAR than you expected, don't immediately rush off and change your preferences just because you can apply for a course with a higher Selection Rank now. If you're happy with your preferences, then stick with them – there's no such thing as 'wasting' a good ATAR.

You might feel pressured into thinking you should change your list, particularly if your friends are talking about changing theirs and cut-off dates are coming up. But just take a minute and spend some time researching any changes you're thinking of making, and be sure you're making the changes for all the right reasons.

OUR TOP CHANGE OF PREFERENCE TIPS

- 1. Spend some time considering why you want to change your preferences before you go ahead and do it 2. Check if any fees or cut-off dates (and times) apply
- 3. If you're unsure about what to do, pick up the phone and call someone at the TAC or university for advice

CHANGE OF PREFERENCE INFORMATION SESSIONS

If you want to know more, lots of unis hold information days and expos around change of preference time. It's a great chance to get in touch and ask any questions you might have about your application. If they're not holding any events, you can still contact them by phone, email, or online.
