Thursday 7 May and Friday 8 May are our Wagga Wagga Christian College Photo Days. Due to our growing student numbers, we require part of a second day to complete our photos. On Thursday 7 May, students from **Kindergarten to Year 7 and Years 9 - 12 and sibling photographs will be taken**. Friday 8 May will be our **Preschool and Year 8** photo sessions (between 9am and 10.30am only) with any individual 'catch ups' that are still required.

If a student is unwell, please do not bring them in 'just for the photo', you may email MSP direct to see if there is an opportunity to be photographed at another school later in the year.

We will not be using the envelope ordering system this year, ALL orders need to be placed and paid for via the special MSP link on Compass. The image below will appear when you log in to Compass. Please click on the link and follow the instructions to order and pay for your photos online.

PLEASE NOTE: The presentation of the **Years 7 – 11** group photo will be a collage of all student's individual photos, **NOT** one photo with all the students sitting on tiered seating. Please keep this in mind when ordering your photo packs. The group photo for **Kindergarten to Year 6 plus Year 12** will be the traditional group photo on tiered seating. This is not a decision made by the College, this is the normal practise of the photographers and is in line with schools across the region.

All students will have their photos taken in order to update our student files whether you decide to purchase photos or not.

Please do not make any appointments during school time for your children on these days as changes to the photography schedule may need to happen on the spot and we cannot reschedule class photos for your child.

Family Photos - All family photos will be taken on Thursday 7 May at 8.50am in the Drama Room (M03). Siblings who have ordered a family photo online are to go straight to the Drama room on arrival at the College. **You MUST pre-order family photos online to be able to have these taken.**

Uniform - Please send students to school in their **full formal Wagga Wagga Christian College winter uniform**. This means **long-sleeved** College shirts for both girls and boys, and ties for the boys. As many students do not own a College woollen jumper, all students will be photographed in class groups without jumpers. For individual photos, students may still wear their jumper if parents prefer.
