

A free, six-week parenting program

Bringing Up Great Kids promotes respectful and caring relationships between parents / carers and their children.

It supports parents and carers of children aged 0-10 years to:

- reflect on their parenting style and what has influenced it
- learn more about brain development and its influence on their children's thoughts, feelings, and behaviour
- understand and respond more mindfully to their children's behaviour
- build effective communication with their children
- consider ways to take care of themselves and find support if they need it.
