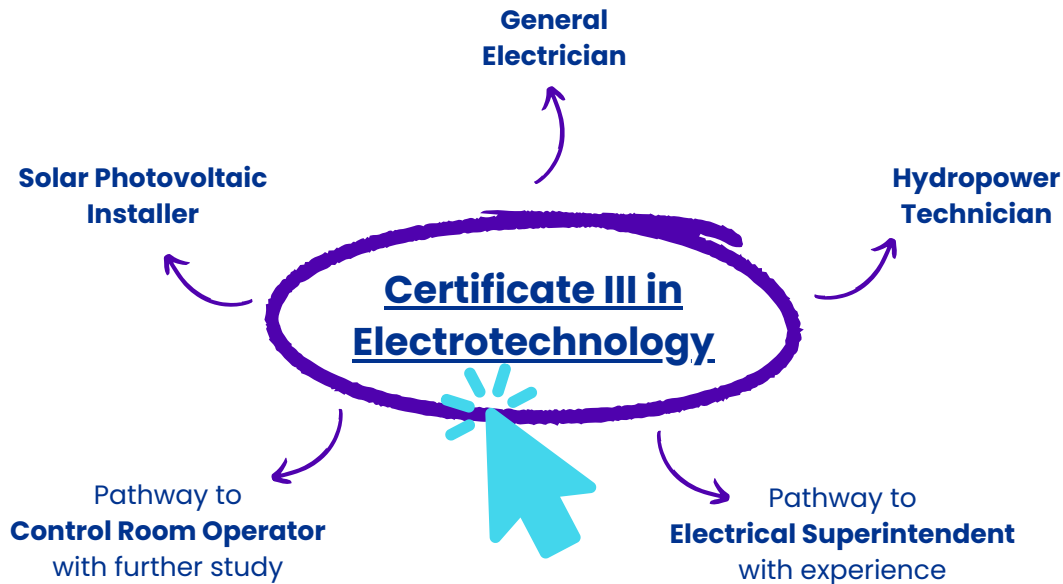

They install wires, outlets, and switches to power lights, appliances, and gadgets. They also fix electrical problems, like when the lights flicker, fuses blow or outlets stop working.
