I would like to provide you with an update regarding our Year 3/4 cohort as we move towards Term 3.

Over the course of the year, our Year 3/4 classes have continued to grow as enrolments increase across our school. 3/4B – Mrs Tanjil-lea Delport

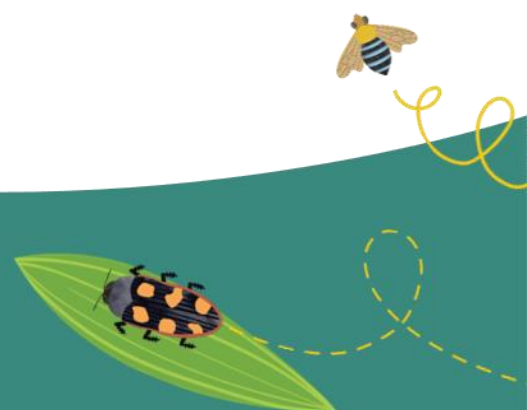
From the beginning of Term 3, we will add an additional class:

In Term 1, she supported our Year 5/6 cohort, and throughout Term 2 she has worked across a range of year levels, supporting teaching and learning programs throughout the school.

Mrs Taylor brings a variety of strengths to the role and has a proven ability to build strong, positive relationships with students. She has already begun working closely with Mrs Hilton and Mrs Delport to support a smooth transition and attended the Year 3/4 planning day this week. Mrs Nikki Kent will continue to work alongside the Year 3/4 team to provide additional support and curriculum leadership.
