

Primary Uniform Code

The uniform of a John XXIII College student is a symbol of membership of the College community. It assists students to develop a feeling of unity and belonging and encourages a sense of pride in appearance.

Management

All students, parents and staff have a role to play in uniform management.

STUDENTS – must be fully aware of the uniform code.

PARENTS – must be fully aware of the uniform requirements, check children at home and respond to College communications.

STAFF – all College staff share co-responsibility to manage the School Uniform Code.

College Standards

This Primary Uniform Code applies at all times when students are required to wear their College uniform before, during and after school.

BOYS:

This consists of:

College shirt

College shorts or trousers

College navy socks with gold band

Black lace up school shoes (or Navy school sandals in Terms 1 & 4)

College jumper *

College hat to be worn for all outdoor activities. '

GIRLS:

This consists of:

College shirt

College skirt

College shorts or trousers

College navy socks with gold band

Navy tights (can only be worn with College skirt)

Black lace up school shoes (or Navy school sandals in Terms 1 & 4)

Accessories

The following jewellery may be worn:

A simple metallic neck chain (Christian symbol)

A simple watch (please see below regarding Smart Watches)

A single stud or sleeper worn in each ear lobe only.

Sports Uniform

College sports shirt

College blue shorts

College sports socks

Predominantly white sports shoes with white laces

College track suit

College bathers (girls), quick dry shorts (boys)

ALL students must have a House coloured polo shirt for House Sport events (and other special events)

ALL students must wear the College rashie for swimming.

Personal Presentation

Uniform items are to be neat/clean

Nail polish cannot be worn

Navy bike shorts can be worn under skirts.

Personal Grooming

Fashionable extremes in hair and colour are not acceptable

Excessively short hair is not permitted

Hair must be clean, brushed and kept off the face

Shoulder length hair is tied back with a navy blue scrunchy, ribbon or elastic band

Bagg

John XXIII College bag is required by all PP – Year 6 students.

Leaders' Shirts

Leaders shirts may be worn by Year 6 students on PE/Sports days in Terms 1-3 and every day in Term 4.

Smart Watches

Primary students are not permitted to bring or wear any sort of Smart watch, Apple watch, Garmin, Fitbit or similar personal device to school. Our priority is for the students to maintain focus on learning throughout the day and not be distracted by these items.

Please note that students who do wear these devices to school will be required to leave the device at Front Administration and then collect it at the end of the school day.

* NOTE: All jumpers, hats and school bags need to be clearly labelled.
