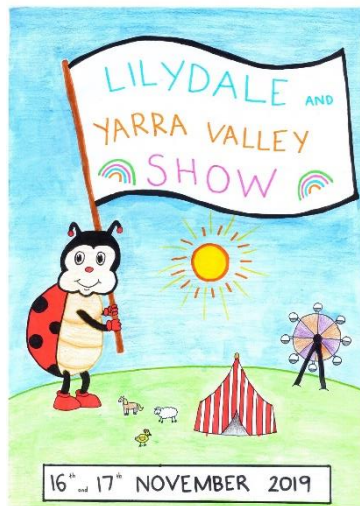

Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Produce a colourful and original A3 Poster – Vertical Form Only • Please note no A4 formats can be considered • All participating students must be full time students of their respective schools • The finished artwork must be the sole work of the student. • Group entries are not permitted • Only one entry per student is permitted
Content of Poster:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The poster artwork should reflect the Lilydale & Yarra Valley Show. Common themes are art & craft, horses, goats, poultry, sheep, wool, cookery, rabbits, flowers & plants, show rides, fireworks, wood chop etc. • You do not need to include all of the above ideas
Medium:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please only use paint & textas to ensure vivid reproduction of the poster • We recommend using bright vivid colours to ensure the best copy of your poster
Must include:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LILYDALE & YARRA VALLEY SHOW – 16TH & 17TH November, 2019 • Leader Newspaper Logo (included above) – approx. 5mm x 10mm high • Please note that if the Leader Logo is not included we will need to add it to your finished poster. We advise leaving a space for it be placed.
Identification:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The finished artwork must be identified on the back with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Artist name (we will only advertise first name and last initial) - School name, contact and phone number
Closing Date:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wednesday 8th September 2022 • Deliver: Lilydale & Yarra Valley Show Office, 27 Market St, Lilydale on Wednesdays • Post: PO Box 70, Lilydale 3140
Judges:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judged by representatives of the Lilydale & Yarra Valley Show • Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
Winning Entry:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The winning students school will be notified by telephone and email to arrange a presentation during school assembly
