



Student Advisory Council:

Students have a positive contribution to make advising within the decision-making processes of the school. When students are actively involved in these processes, they have an enhanced sense of commitment to the school.

The Student Advisory Council operates in the following manner:

- Members consist of 2 representatives from each class, voted by their classroom peers.
- Meet with the principal once a term.
- Prior to the meeting each class has a class meeting to determine the ideas/concerns that the members bring to the meeting.
- Minutes from the meeting are shared with staff.
- A summary of the meeting is shared with each class by the attending members.
