Successful applicants will only need to pay the first \$30 of their course fee with the balance being paid by the Smart Region Incubator. All applications will be assessed by Seasons of New England and the Smart Region Incubator.

Following the workshop weekend, the Smart Region Incubator and Seasons of New England would like to follow up by coming to your school (or another location you might wish to nominate) to talk with the participants about their experience. We'd love to see if the experience has sparked some business ideas, to hear how students found the workshops and to understand what support they might need to pursue their ideas in the future.

Who is the Smart Region Incubator?

The UNE SMART Region Incubator (UNE SRI) helps to turn ideas for business into reality. We offer support and programs which are free to anyone who wants to road-test an idea that might grow into a business. The UNE SRI would like to support 10 students to join a workshop and see how this could grow into a business opportunity.
