The Executive and General Committee members attend all meetings and are asked to take leadership or support others in the fundraising and socials events that are conducted throughout the year including (but not limited to)

- Mothers Day & Fathers Day Stalls
- Bunnings & Election Day Sausage Sizzles and Cake Stalls
- Working Bees
- Annual Parents only event (i.e gala dinner, trivia night or comedy for a cause)
- School Disco

- Coordinating Class Reps (The role of a class rep is separate to being involved in the PFA)
- Liasing with School Council with updates on events, approval of budgets etc

Please note that joining the PFA does not include the roles of classroom rep or classroom helpers for reading, excursions etc. That is managed separately once school commences in 2024. A representative from PFA will send a separate registration form to nominate yourself to be a class rep for 2024 next February. Classroom helpers are managed directly by the teachers for each class.
