### ANDREWS CUP BASKETBALL

The Andrews Cup Basketball competition will be held at **The Coomera Indoor Sports Centre, 35 Beattie Road, Coomera, on Thursday 4 November 2021.** Competition will commence at 9:00am and conclude at 2:45pm, followed by Presentations.

#### **TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS:**

Transport to and from Coomera will be by chartered bus. Students are to assemble at the Tuckshop area promptly at **6:45am** to have their name marked off the roll before departure. The bus will then return to Clayfield College, Bayview Terrace, at approximately **4:30pm**.

Students may travel home with their parents/caregivers from the venue but must check out with a Clayfield College teacher before leaving. All students are required to stay for the presentation.

**WHAT TO WEAR:** Clayfield College basketball baggy shorts and singlet (provided by the College)  
Sports shoes and white sports socks

**WHAT TO TAKE:** CC tracksuit/jumper if needed

Morning tea, Lunch, snacks and water for the day - please note, girls may require more than 1 drink bottle and these bottles must be clearly named.

#### **SPECTATORS:**

Currently, **1** spectator per family will be permitted at this event; however, spectators will only be allowed entry to the venue under strict adherence to the COVID safe plan. These requirements include:

- Spectators must sign in electronically or on paper prior to entry to the venue and sign out on departure of the venue, including hand sanitising.
- Masks must be worn inside the venue.
- Spectators (1 per family), are to remain in their school areas to watch the games regardless of court position. Free movement around the facility will not be allowed, unless moving to an entry/exit point, or to access bathroom facilities.
- Individuals must not attend the event if they have COVID-19 symptoms.
- The school has the right to refuse service and must insist that anyone with these symptoms leaves the venue.

Please note that this information pertaining to spectators being allowed to attend the competition, can change at any point between now and the competition, as we continue to manage the continuous and evolving effects of the current health pandemic.
