

### Summer Reading @ Hilltops – Terms and Conditions

Your contact information will be retained by Hilltops Council Library to be used only for the purposes of the Summer Reading @ Hilltops competitions **(Hilltops Summer Reading Club & Hilltops.Read.Share. Social media campaign)**. You are able to opt out at any time by contacting the library on 02 6384 2440 or emailing <u>librarypromotions@hilltops.nsw.gov.au</u> unless competition information has been released into the public domain in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

### Submission of an entry is deemed acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

### 1) Entry Eligibility for the following competitions are:

#### Hilltops Summer Reading Club

- Entry is open to all and only primary school students in Hilltops LGA and surrounds
- To enter you must be a Library Member (New Members are always welcome!)
- An entrant of competition must be an individual and not a group or organisation

#### Hilltops.Read.Share Social media campaign

- Entry is open to all residents in Hilltops LGA and surrounds over 13 years of age
- To enter you must be a Library Member (Mew Members are always welcome!)
- An entrant of competition must be an individual and not a group or organisation

#### 2) Entry Details

- Entrants must register their interest by contacting the library on 02 6384 2440 or by attending a branch to complete a registration form
- To enter any of the competitions and be eligible for a prize, participant must have completed and submitted at least one reading log or photo/book review/social media post
- All fields in the submission of entries must be completed and permission granted by a parent or guardian where necessary
- Entries must be submitted within the competition period and received by **5pm, Tuesday 8 Feburary 2022** (close of competition)

#### 3) How to enter Hilltops Summer Reading Club

- Entrants must first register for the Hilltops Summer Club with their library card either online (insert form link), by calling the library 02 6384 2440 or at the library branch
- At a minimum, one reading log must be completed and submitted either by emailing <u>librarypromotions@hilltops.nsw.gov.au</u> or submitted to staff at a Hilltops library branch, to enter the competitions and be eligible for prizes
- 1 hour of reading (this includes: solo reading, reading aloud to someone or listening to someone read either in person or an audio book) is an entry into the prize draw.
- All fields in the submission of the entries must be completed and permission granted by a parent or guardian
- Entries must be submitted within the competition period. Competitions close **5pm Tuesday 8 February 2022**

#### 4) How to enter Hilltops.Read.Share social media campaign

• Entrants can enter by submitting a creative photo of what/where they are reading with their book or a brief book review recommendation post by emailing <u>librarypromotions@hilltops.nsw.gov.au</u> or messaging the library through the Hilltops Council Library Facebook page message function.

## 5) Prizes

- Winners of each competition and prize draw will be presented during the week beginning **14 February 2022**
- Should a prize remain unclaimed and the library has made every effort to contact the winner with the information provided on the entry form, or should the winner not wish or not be able to accept a prize, the prize will be awarded to the runner up. The runners up will only be notified if they have won a prize
- In the event that a prize becomes unavailable, Hilltops Council Library reserves the right to provide a similar product, subject to any applicable laws and or written directions
- The prizes are not transferrable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash or other incentives

# 6) Judging

- Entries are judged on set criteria for each competition; this includes completing the set requirements, providing the correct answers, originality, creativity and the submission of at least one reading log or social media post/photo
- Judges will take into account the grade of the child
- Entries must be original and the entrant's own work
- Entries will be judged by the panel and winners selected by Friday 11 February 2022
- The judge's decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into

## 7) Announcement and distribution

- Winners will be notified by phone and officially announced by **Monday 14 February 2022**
- Prizes will be presented **Monday 14 February 2022** or able to be collected at agreed date and time from the library

8) Hilltops Council and its Library reserve the right to retain, duplicate, display and publish the entry online. Only first names and ages (if under 18) will be published.

**9)** Entries will not be returned. Every care will be taken but the organisers do not assume responsibility for loss or damage. Please retain a copy of your entry.
