George Woods Boat Ramp Car Park Upgrade – Construction Commencing

Works to upgrade the George Woods Car Park are due to commence soon.

Funded as part of Better Boating Victoria's \$2.6 million commitment to improve boating activities in Kingston, the car park works will aim to increase parking numbers within the carpark and renew the ageing pavement.

Better Boating Victoria managed the recent pontoon improvement works and is working with Council to upgrade the carpark.

The proposed improvements will include:

- Relocating the car park entry, away from the pedestrian crossing to improve safety.
- The creation of up to nine additional parking bays and a queuing lane for boat trailers waiting to access the ramp. (This is expected to reduce congestion along Governor Road and side streets).
- Construction of a new footpath along Governor Road in front of the Car Park to improve pedestrian safety, accessibility and connectivity to the bus stop.
- Construction of new shared path networks around the car park to improve pedestrian connectivity.
- Provision of an accessible bay for all abilities access, and
- The removal of some trees that are in poor health and planting a larger number of trees and associated landscaping around the carpark.

Construction details

Works are expected to commence in March 2022, in the off-peak boating season, with expected completion in mid-2022.

During the works the car park will be closed for public safety reasons. Works may also restrict access to some pedestrian areas for short periods.

Council will aim to minimise disruption to the area and visitors should keep an eye out for any detour signage in place during the construction.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.

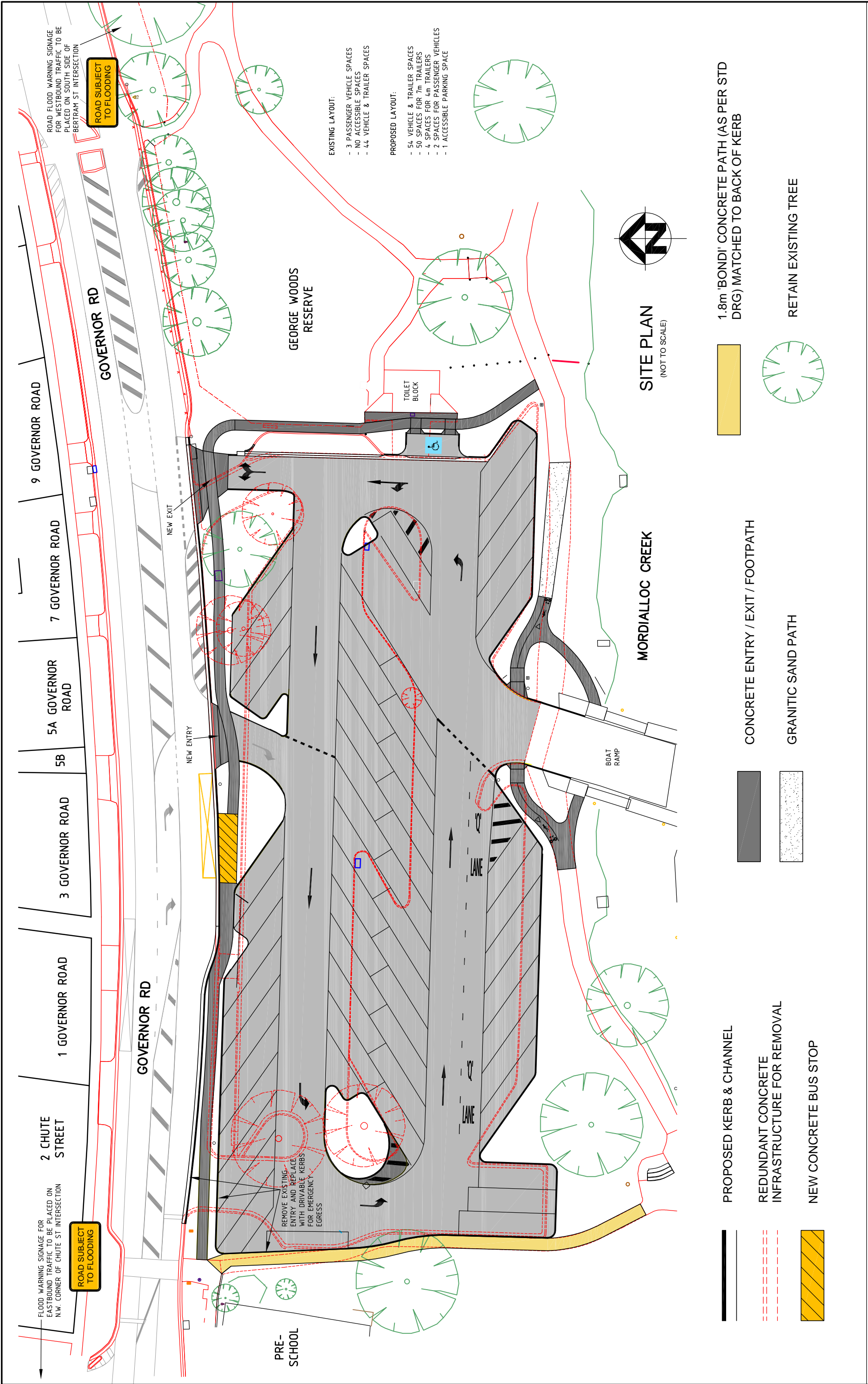

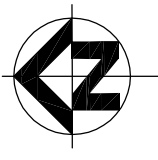

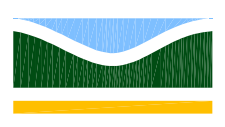
