## CAREERS IN AGRICULTURE

**Agriculture isn't just farming-** It is focussed on "the entire food chain, managing the environment and minimising the impact of human endeavours on natural resources".

About 50% of all jobs in the agriculture industry are in capital cities. These jobs include environmental management, research, development, agribusiness and education.

Most people in agriculture work full time.

The demand for agricultural science graduates grew strongly over the past 5 years and around 6000 job openings will be available by 2020, <https://bit.ly/2HZWFel>
