As we commence the school year there are some matters, I would like to bring to your attention:

1. A cashless system in 2024

As communicated last year, St Pius X College has decided to transition to a cashless system in 2024.

Students can choose from two payment methods at the canteen:

- a) **EFTPOS card**: This would involve using a physical card issued by a financial institution.
- b) **Flexischools***: Flexischools is a platform that facilitates online ordering and payments at the canteen.

*New students who haven't been issued student cards can still use Flexischools once an account is linked to their student profile.

To set up a Flexischools account, visit the Flexischools website (<u>https://flexischools.com.au/</u>) and follow the instructions provided. When prompted to enter the student's barcode





number, enter the first section of their college email address. For example, if the email address is <u>JSMIT01@stpiusx.nsw.edu</u>, enter "JSMIT01" as the barcode number.

Once the account is activated and the student is linked, the student can present the barcode number to the canteen. Purchased items will be added to their account. Once student cards are issued, the student must present their student card at the canteen to use their Flexischools account.

2. Clipboard

3. New Student Management System – Sentral

- In 2024, St Pius X College has made the decision to move from the iWise Student Management System and Portal to a new platform known as Sentral. During the year, the College will gradually role out Sentral modules and decommission elements of iWise.
- The first Sentral modules to be rolled out include: teacher roll marking, student timetables, the St. Pius X College Calendar and access to the Student Portal. Access to the student portal will be provided to students in the coming days. Students will receive an email with detailed instructions regarding login information and how to navigate the Sentral Portal.
- While the College transitions to Sentral, it will continue to maintain access to iWise until the rollout is finalised. More information regarding Sentral can be found at: https://www.sentral.com.au/parents-portal

4. New starting time and finishing times:

- A reminder that the Movement Bell will sound at 8.30am with all students to be at their Homeroom by 8.30am.
- The day will conclude at 3.10pm for students in Years 7-12.

5. New Homeroom structure for Senior school except Year 12.

- In 2024, students have been allocated a homeroom based on their House.
- Each House has an A and B class with students from the House shared equally between the two homerooms.
- Siblings should be in the same House across the school. Please inform your Pastoral Coordinator if this is not the case.
