# The Important Stuff...

Please read the information below regarding the holiday program.

# What to bring

As the children will be active for a large portion of the day, please remember to bring appropriate footwear such as runners. We also require hats as the weather and UV are expected to present a risk during this period.

Applying sunscreen before entering the program is advised, making sure you provide your own sunscreen if your child has allergies. The Cancer Council recommends using a high-protection sunscreen (Minimum SPF 30) with a high UVA rating (4-star minimum).

# Medication and plans

If your child has a medical condition such as Asthma or Anaphylaxis, please make sure you have provided an updated action plan when providing your booking form. Please provide the required medications directly to the Responsible Person onsite on the first day of attendance. Medications must be in their original packaging, clearly labeled with your child's name and a use-by date. \*\*Please note children are unable to attend the program without their medication and action plans.

# **Bookings and cancellations**

Bookings are subject to availability and can be made, changed or canceled up until the 21st of June without incurring a late fee of \$15. Cancellations made after this date will incur the normal fee and will be charged accordingly.

# **Lunch and snack**

Children will need to bring a packed lunch, recess snack and refillable water bottle each day. When packing your child's lunch, please consider that some children in attendance have been diagnosed with food allergies or the risk of anaphylaxis.

Afternoon tea will be provided daily. Breakfast will be provided at 8am - 8:20 am for those that need.

# **Child Care Subsidy and payment of accounts**

After your booking has been placed, you must log into your MyGov account to check you have a confirmed enrolment with the Elysium OSHC site you have selected.

Vacation Care is offered to the families on a fee for service basis. These fees allow us the ability to pay for wages, resources, food and associated bills. Without the regular payment of fees, we could not afford to keep the service operating, which would disadvantage the families and community. We therefore need to have conditions on the payment of holiday program accounts so that we can afford to remain financially viable. A **deposit will be required prior** to the commencement of the program, and will be detailed in the confirmation letter/email - bookings cannot be fully confirmed until the deposit is paid. At the end of the holiday program, **account statements** will be provided and **must be paid within 14 days** of the program's end date. Late fees apply to those that do not meet this schedule, and a review of the child's enrolment will occur where families have not provided a satisfactory timeframe or entered a payment plan for the outstanding holiday program debt.
