ISA Summer Sport Finals Saturday 13th March 2021 Spectator Information - Basketball

- The ISA has endeavoured to make the Finals available to as many spectators as possible, based on the practical management of spectators and venue restrictions. Courts 1 & 2 and 5 & 6 are allowed 2 spectators per player, and courts 3 & 4 are allowed 1 spectator per player.
- In light of this, all Open & 17 Yrs Fixtures have been scheduled on Courts 1, 2, 5 & 6 where 2 spectators per player will be allowed so that parents with a son or daughter in their final year of school have the opportunity to watch them play.
- All staff, students and spectators are required to enter via the main entry and are to wait in their designated court area out the front until called in. (See Map). An ISA COVID Official will assist with entry.
- No court entry will be permitted until the previous games teams & spectators have exited the courts.
- Entry to courts will be staggered with players, coaches, managers and officials first, and then spectators.
- Spectators will need to Sign in using the venue QR Code and must have a wrist band distributed by their school. ISA Rubber wrist bands will be collected upon entry.
- All spectators are to obey PVRSC and ISA signage at all times.
- The Canteen will only be accessible upon entry and during the allocated game time as all teams and spectators must leave promptly after each game through the allocated Exit Doors on each court area.
- There must be one vacant seat between each spectator or spectator pair in the stands. No singing or chanting is allowed in the stands.
- Spectators must abide by the Changeroom/Toilet person limit indicated on each door.
- Maintain 1.5m social distancing at all times.
