			<p>state schools in later grades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Suggest a conversation with MACS and also Regional Lead on enrolment policies - Unclear who governs enrolment policies - Unclear whether feeder schools is a formal system - Anna confirmed that MACS policy preferences “catholic children” from non-catholic primary schools over “non-catholic children” who have attended catholic primary schools - ACTION: Matt to organise for local group to meet with Mary at St Al’s (Annunciation, St Augustine’s, Corpus Christi, St John’s, St Monica’s) and report back to PAC in August - TBC whether someone to raise concerns with MACS, as this poses a risk to primary school enrolments
