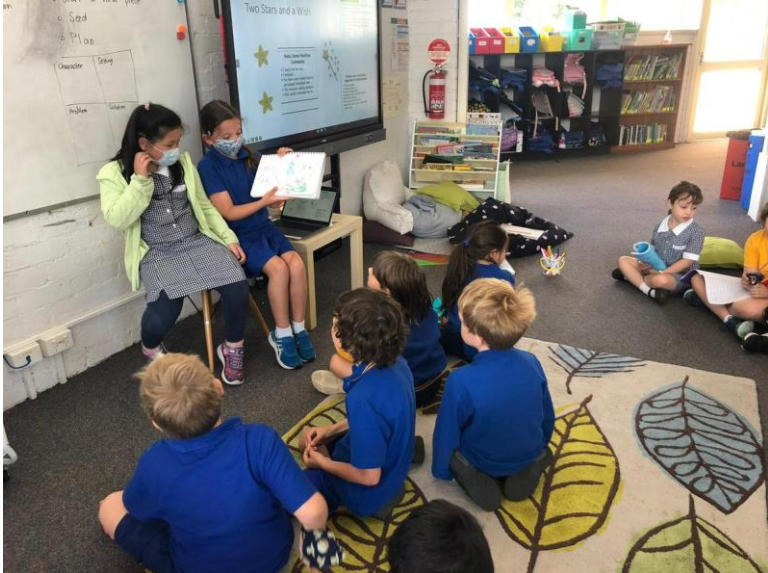
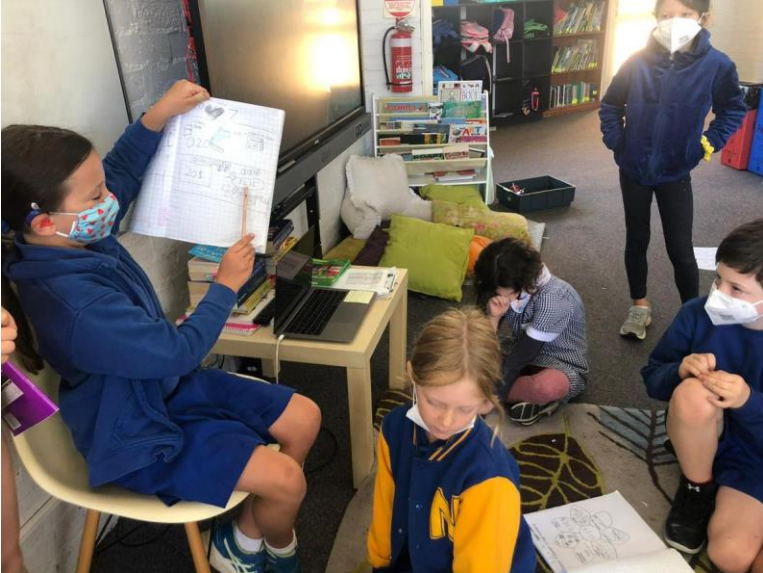

- ▶ 50:50 English/Spanish lessons
- ▶ Shared classroom of two teachers
- ▶ The Newlands approach to the delivery of the Victorian Curriculum is taught in both English and Spanish.
- ▶ Both languages are taught 50/50
- ▶ We use CLIL (Content Language Integrated Learning) and TPRS (Teaching Proficiency through Reading and Storytelling)
- ▶ Term 1 Focus: Speaking and Listening and developing Spanish Vocabulary
- ▶ During the last week of every term, we celebrate a Spanish speaking country by exploring significant cultural events/activities.

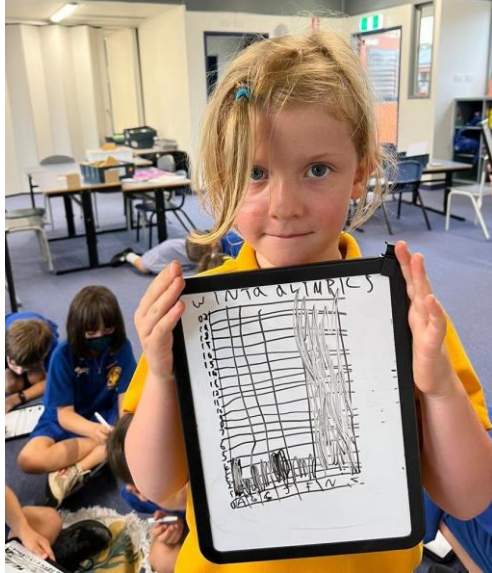

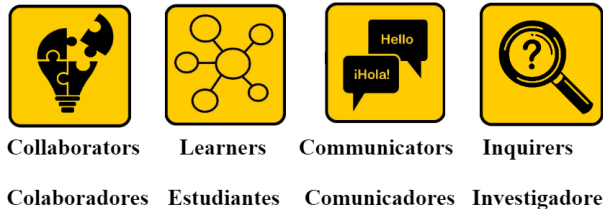
Developmental Management

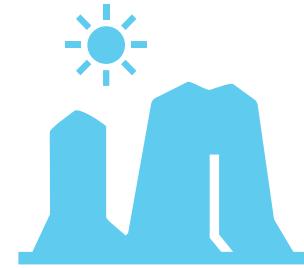




T1 and T4 wear hats
