- Term 1 Focus: Speaking and Listening and developing Spanish Vocabulary


During the last week of every term, we celebrate a Spanish speaking country by exploring significant cultural events/activities.









### BILINGUAL LITERACY MODEL

The Code






### BILINGUAL NUMERACY MODEL


