# Clyde Road – February road and rail closure

The Victorian Government is removing 17 dangerous level crossings, including the one at Clyde Road as part of a \$16 billion investment to upgrade the Pakenham line that will improve safety, reduce congestion and allow more trains to run more often.

Major works are underway to build the new Clyde Road underpass.

From **10pm Friday 19 February to 5am Friday 26 February** we'll work around the clock during a closure of the Pakenham line. Works will include piling for the new rail bridge, relocating rail infrastructure and installing drainage under the rail line.

## What to expect

- Road and lane closures along Clyde Road with detours and reduced speed limits
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours and traffic management to help you move safely through the area
- Direct notification from utility providers in advance of any disruption to services
- Construction workers, heavy vehicle activity and moderate noise and vibrations.

# Night works

Works will take place 24 hours a day within the rail corridor during this time. Some additional out of hours works may also be required throughout the month.

We'll notify impacted residents ahead of night works and minimise impacts where possible.

## Road closure

Clyde Road will be closed in both directions between Enterprise Avenue and Reserve Street/Jane Street from:

- 10pm Friday 19 February to 5am Monday 22 February; and
- 10pm to 5am each night until Friday 26 February.

You can detour via Princes Highway/ Freeway (M1) interchange or Princes Highway/ Beaconsfield interchange. Local property and business access will be maintained and detour signs will be in place. Refer to detour map overleaf.

Please note, there are other ongoing traffic changes in the area. Visit our website for more information.

### Buses replace trains on the Pakenham Line

Buses replace trains on sections of the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines from **10pm Friday 19 February to last service Thursday 25 February**.

Up to 220 car spaces will also be closed in Berwick Station car park to enable train replacement bus services to safely operate.

# Pedestrian changes

From 10pm Friday 19 February to 5am Friday 26 February, pedestrian access will be closed across the level crossing and along the eastern side of Clyde Road between Berwick Station and Kangan Drive.

Pedestrians can access Berwick Station via Reserve Street or Kangan Drive. Local access to businesses remains open.

Traffic management and detour signs will help you move safely through the area.















