
Word Scramble: How many words can you make using the letters below? Every word must use the centre letter and be at least three letters long. The same letter can be used multiple times in each word.

Math Bowling:

Numbers: 4, 4, 5		
5- 4= 1	5 + (4 ÷ 4)= 6	
√4= 2	$4 + (5 - \sqrt{4}) = 7$	
$5 - (\sqrt{4}) = 3$	4 + 4 = 8	
$\sqrt{4} + \sqrt{4} = 4$	4 + 5= 9
