

ST PIUS X COLLEGE WINTER SPORTS COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and spectators attending school sport at St Pius X College.

Pre-Attendance Agreement

Please do not attend St Pius X College sports fixtures as either a player, staff or spectator if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19
- are at a high health risk including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals
- have recently visited various locations of identified COVID-19 clusters

Attendance

Only the following people will be permitted onsite:

- Players
- Coaches
- Faculty/Sport staff
- Match Officials
- Medical staff
- Spectators: Family members only.

Social distancing protocols must be followed, always, while on site.

Entry points

- For Rugby and Football at Oxford Falls, entry off Dreadnought Road
- For Tennis at Love 'n' Deuce entry off Talus Street

Facilities

- Canteen and BBQ facilities will be available on site from Term 2 onwards
- Separate toilets will be available for players and adults. Toilets are clearly marked
- Changerooms for ISA Rugby and Football are for changing only. No meetings or congregating inside allowed
- Stand areas are clearly marked with social distancing in mind
- Water bubblers are operational
- Facilities will be continuously cleaned throughout the day
- Good hygiene practices must be adhered to while using all facilities
- First aid will be available onsite
- Post-match receptions will be provided for 1st XV Rugby and 1st XI Football
- St Pius X College has a no dogs policy

Player Information

We ask that players:

- Arrive in playing uniform with the exception of 1st XV Rugby and 1st XI Football who should arrive in full winter uniform.
- Bring and use their own hand sanitiser
- Bring their own clearly marked drink bottle no sharing permitted
- Huddles, handshakes and high fives are discouraged
- No spitting under any circumstances

Upon the completion of the sports fixture, we ask that players, staff and spectators, with the exception of those players "backing up" or involved in 1st XV Rugby and 1st XI Football, adhere to social distancing practices and move offsite immediately. Spectators and players are only permitted on site for the game they intend to watch or are playing in.
