# FEES SCHEDULE EXPLAINED

## Essential Student Learning Items

All items and activities which are essential for your son/daughter to learn the standard curriculum as listed per year level. This includes items that your son/daughter will take possession of, materials for final products that your son/daughter takes home. It also includes software/online subscriptions such as Edrolo, Maths Essential. It also includes Student ID Cards and excursions or work placements that all students must attend.

## Optional Items

We offer a range of optional items and activities that are additional to the delivery of the standard curriculum. These items and activities are designed to broaden the school experience for your son/daughter.

E.g. extra curricular camp, excursions and activities, Music lessons

In addition, we offer a range of extra-curricular activities and facilities that are unique to Mornington Secondary College. With the contributions of parents, referred to as the Student Service Charge, we can subsidise the costs of

- Compass parent/student portal
- Swimming pool operations
- College mini-bus operations
- Maintenance of buildings, which includes the basketball stadium
- Classroom sets of books and resources
- General equipment repair and maintenance e.g. science equipment
- Extensive grounds improvements – garden beds, retaining walls, seating and sports and playing fields

Although optional, without parent contributions, the College would not be able to offer such extensive facilities for your son/daughter.

## Exiting or not returning to Mornington Secondary College in 2021

It is essential that if your son/daughter is not returning to Mornington Secondary College in 2021, an Exit Form must be completed before the student's final day at the College.

Students transferring to another Secondary School are required to complete an Exit Form following their formal interview with their new school.

Students transitioning to TAFE or exiting the education system must attend a formal interview with the Pathways Team and complete Exit Forms. For students under 17 years of age, an application for a DET school exemption must be completed and approved before the student can leave school.

Without a completed Exit Form your son/daughter remains enrolled at the College and is expected to attend all classes. Please contact the General Office for Exit Forms.

**STEP 1:** You will be prompted to answer a few questions regarding the acceptance of College School Policies **Please note you cannot continue unless you answer all questions.**

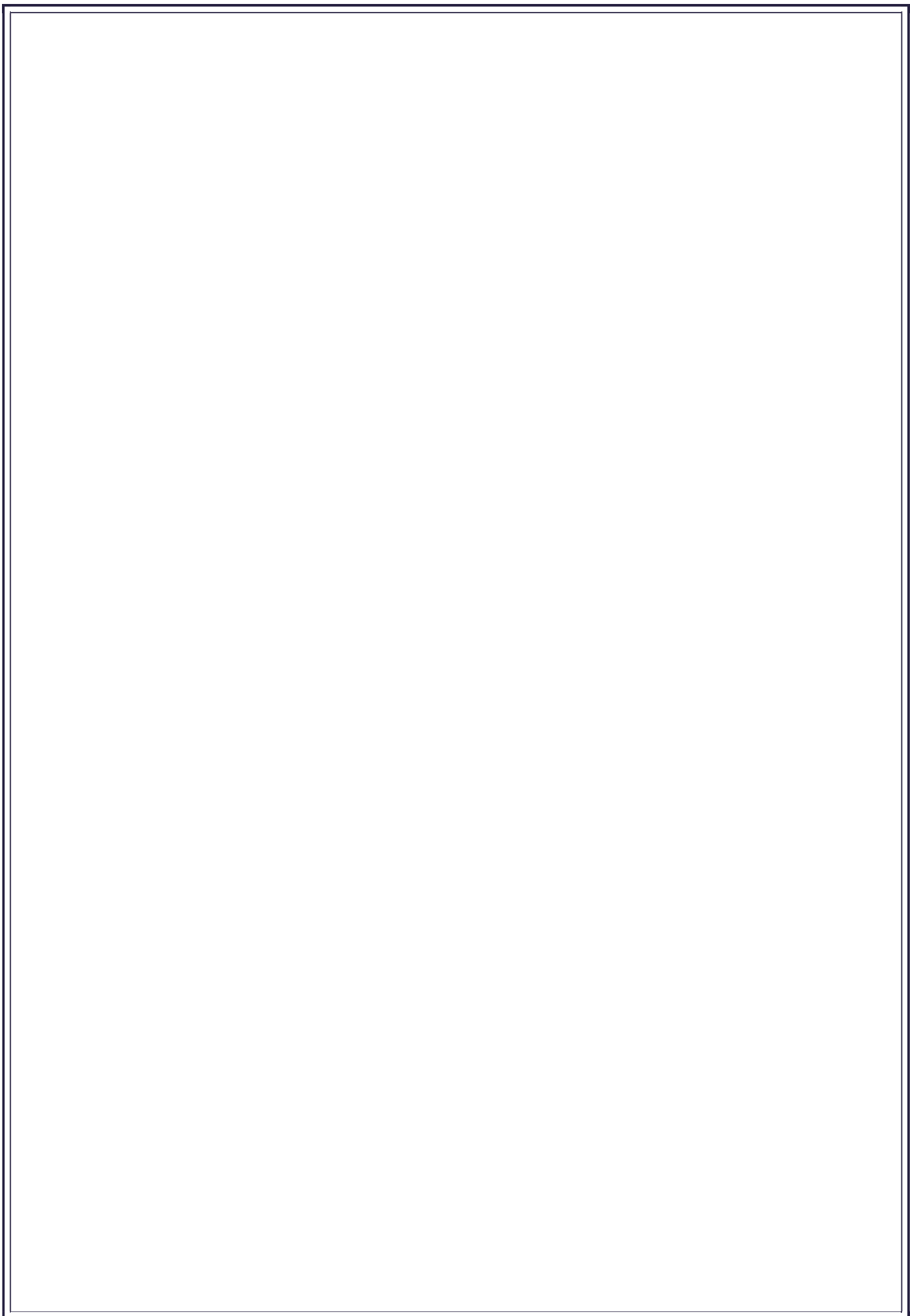
