In Uluru there are a bunch of various different animals that are made to survive through the arid climate such as the bilby, red kangaroo, spinifex hopping mouse. One of the most popular animal is the dingo. The dingo plays an important role in Uluru because the dingo hunts many kinds of animals to maintain the balance of the ecosystem in Uluru. The sandy coloured dingo usually communicate by howling at night or to pee on objects. The important dingo is known to look alike like a dog as it is closely related to a dog. The dingoes fur is usually sandy or a deep reddish brown. The mammal has a broad head, pointed muzzle and erect ears. The most common height is up to 52 to 60 cm. The dingo usually howl at night to keep of intruders. Did you know? that dingoes rarely bark to communicate. The dingo is an incredible animal which is as important as the other animals found in Uluru.
